First part of these 24 hours
Commences with strong winds and
heavy seas from W S W latter
part moderate winds from W S W
heading by the wind & whole
top sail set Lat Long

Sunday Dec 15. 1867

First of these 24 hours, light
winds and clear weather
from W S W heading south
latter part moderate from W S W
heading S at noon steered N E to
all sail set so on Lat 27.12 Long 14.32

Monday Dec 16. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with fine clear
weather from S E W latter part
calm the watch employed
Bending sails & so ends

Tuesday Dec 17. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with calm the
watch employed bending
sails latter part calm the watch
employed ships duty Lat 27.0.44.42

Wednesday Dec 18. 1867

First part of these 24 hours commences
with light airs and clear weather
from westward heading by the
wind S W by W all sail set
latter part the same employed ships
duty so ends this day Lat 26.00

Thursday Dec 19. 1867

First part of these 24 hours moderate
winds and clear weather from
westward latter part the same
so ends this day 25.37.15.26

Friday Dec 20. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with light winds squally
from eastward latter part moderate
winds from N E steering S W
Lat 26.16. Long 16.08

Saturday Dec 21. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with light winds from
the northward latter part fresh winds
and clear weather from eastward
steering W S E so ends
Lat 26.10. Long 17.41

Sunday Dec 22. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate winds
and clear weather from eastward
latter part fresh breeze from N E
steering S W by W so ends this day
Lat Long

Monday Dec 23. 1867

First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate winds
and clear weather from
eastward steering course
N W by W at sunset shorten
sails and headed to eastward
latter part the same employed ships
duty so on Lat 27.22 Long 19.30
