

Monday June the 29. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate winds
and squally weather from
the westward heading to
Eastward with all sail set
at sundown shorten sail
latter part fine weather Employed
repairing fore top sail so ends

Tuesday June 30. 1868
First part of these 24 hours commences
with fine weather at noon rose a
schooner at 2 p.m. bent fore
top sail at 6 p.m. rose a whale going
quick to leeward lowered 2 boats
chase untill dark and came on
board latter part the same at 10. a.m.
lowered for black fish and got 4 so
ends this day

Wednesday July the 1. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate winds
and cloudy weather from S.E. & E
having all sail set at sundown
shorten sail latter part squally so
ends this day

Thursday July 2. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with rainy weather
at sundown set again sail and
up jib and headed by the wind
S.E. by E latter part the same
so ends this day

Friday July the 3. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate winds and
cloudy weather from Eastward
heading by the wind N.E. & E at
sundown shorten sail latter part
raining so ends this day

Saturday July the 4. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with moderate and
clear weather from S.E. heading
N.W. at 6.5 p.m. rose black fish lowered
2 boats and got one at sundown shorten
sail and headed to northward latter part
strong winds and clear weather from the
Eastward Employed sitting up backstay
so ends this day

Sunday July the 5. 1868
First part of these 24 hours
Commences with strong winds and clear
weather at 1.5 p.m. rose breaches at 2.15 p.m.
lowered for them a schooner being
near to the whales struck and killed
one at sundown shortening sail and headed
by the wind S.E. latter part the same
so ends this day

Monday July the 6. 1868
First part of these 24 hours like
winds and clear weather from
Eastward at 2 p.m. spoke a schooner
latter part the same at day light commenced
sailing black fish at 8 a.m. rose
whales lowered 3 boats chase untill
5 p.m. and came on board
