

Remarks on board

Sunday April 5th 1840

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the S. by E. Middle part the same saw Finbacks 8.00
Latitude of Ch 34.34 Long of Ch 77.20

Monday April 6th 1840

First part fine weather with a moderate wind from the S. by E. Middle part light air latter part at 8 AM saw the Islands of Juan Fernandez bearing N 40 miles W. Latitude with a light air from NW. Completed in tail mending
Latitude of Ch 33.57 Long of Ch 77.30

Tuesday April 7th 1840

First part stiff breeze from NW heading to the N. saw a large ship standing to the N. by E. saw Finbacks Middle part moderate breeze latter part the same saw a great many Finbacks
Latitude of Ch 32.42 Long of Ch 76.58

Wednesday April 8th 1840

First part stiff breeze from NW heading to the N. saw Finbacks Completed in tail mending and other jobs Middle part the same latter part wind NW. at noon took to the NW saw Finbacks
Latitude of Ch 31.50 Long of Ch 75.20

Thursday April 9th 1840

First part fine weather with a moderate wind from NW heading to the NW. Completed in heading of the 1st & 2nd barrels Middle part took a breeze from the NW. at 8 AM launched the log into the sounder deep latter part fine pleasant weather with a nice breeze from South at the Starails saw Completed in repairing and tending sails. S. ends
Latitude of Ch 30.42 Long of Ch 77.0

Friday April 10th

First part fine breeze from South breeze NW Middle part breeze NW. latter part at 7 AM saw a school of sperm Whales put off and took 2 to the ship. S. ends 5 milk cut
Latitude of Ch 28.40 Long of Ch 77.25



Saturday 11th

First part cut one whale in at 5 saw them again but got nothing latter part blowing a strong breeze from S cut in the others one and began to sail

Ship's Station

Sunday April 12th 1840

First part blowing a strong gale from the S. Completed in looking with all sails in Middle & latter much the same
Latitude of Ch 28.35 Long of Ch 78.0

Monday April 13th

First part blowing strong from the S. still sailing Middle part the same still heading to the N. by E. latter part at daylight finished looking and began to steer down
Latitude of Ch 28.40 Long of Ch 79.19

Tuesday April 14th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the S. under short sail Completed in steering oil latter part calm still steering down oil in the M.H.
Latitude of Ch 28.58 Long of Ch 79.50

Wednesday April 15th

First part fine calm weather with work steering down oil Middle part wind to latter part light breeze still steering oil in the Main Hole. S. ends under short sail
Latitude of Ch 28.49 Long of Ch 80.9

Thursday April 16th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the S. heading to the N. by E. still steering down oil S. ends Middle part rainy latter part much the same steering oil S. ends
Latitude of Ch 28.4 Long of Ch 80.0

Friday April 17th

First part thick weather with a moderate breeze from the S. heading to the N. by E. finished steering oil Middle part rainy latter part rainy with a light breeze from the S. made all sails and began repairing and cleaning between decks & washing ship
Latitude of Ch 28.29 Long of Ch 80.40

Saturday April 18th

First part rainy weather with a light breeze from the S. heading to the N. by E. Middle part much the same except rain latter part better weather Completed in cleaning the inside masts at 8 heading to the S. S. ends with Sam Lewis sick and Mess Murray on deck again
Latitude of Ch 27.20 Long of Ch 81.0
