Wednesday June 17th 1840

First part moderate in each more fair & taking about Middle
part much the same latter saw 2 ships & 2 ducks times
Latitude of Ch 6.8 South Long of Ch 104.

Thursday June 18th 1840

First part under single reef & the 2nd sail straight spoke the
laves of the John Middle part stiff breeze standing & the 1st
latter part tacked to the lee saw 1 ship & saw 1 Linck
Latitude of Ch 6.9 Long of Ch 103.58

Friday June 19th 1840

First part strong trade under single reef & sails straight spoke the
to the lee saw 2 Lincks & 2 ducks times it being 4 weeks since we
have seen Whales S. Bends as usual Middle & latter part
Latitude of Ch 6.35 Long of Ch 103.10

Saturday June 20th

First part strong winds & suggests weather saw as ship Middle
part usually latter part much the same S. Bends
Latitude of Ch 4.27 Long of Ch 102.38

Sunday June 21st

First part strong winds Middle & latter part moderate
saw as Linck S. Bends
Latitude of Ch 4.47 Long of Ch 102.57

Monday June 22nd

First part fine weather with some moderate breeze spoke the Java
Middle part lay by latter part run off the 1st
Latitude of Ch 4.48 Long of Ch 104.

Tuesday June 23rd

First part fine weather spoke the *Leopoldine* of Salem
last seen nothing since we saw her last Middle part run off 88
latter part run 44 fine weather &
Latitude of Ch 5.20 Long of Ch 105.

Wednesday 24th

First part strong trade breeze of the wind & the 1st Middle part
much the same latter part of the wind with dull times
Latitude of Ch 4.20 Long of Ch 105.27

Ship Stations of Nantucket

Thursday June 25th 1840

First part fine weather taking about the grounds in hope
of getting in with the Whales soon. Employed in repairing sails
Middle part much the same latter quite moderate made
more sail standing at the Southward S. Bends
Latitude of Ch 7.55 Long of Ch 105.28 of Ch

Friday June 26th 1840

First part stiff trade standing at the 1st straight tacked
to the 1st weather equally Middle part much the same
latter part saw as ship S. Bends
Latitude of Ch 5.27 Long of Ch 106.47

Saturday June 27th

First part strong winds & dull times & dull grounds saw a ship
Middle part lay by latter part signified with the banner
of S. Bends S. Bends took & took withers
Latitude of Ch 5.14 Long of Ch 107.0

Sunday 28th

First part strong trade under double reef & sails straight spoke the
breeze Martin of N.B. should be Peries Middle part much
the same latter part strong breeze from the S. B. saw as last
Latitude of Ch 5.0 Long of Ch 107.20

Monday June 29th

First part strong trade spoke the President of Nantucket
18 miles 700 half Starbuck Middle part lay by latter part
strong breeze S. Bends under single reef & sails
Latitude of Ch 5.50 Long of Ch 108.45

Tuesday June 30th

First part in company with the President & the Lady Amherst
Middle part lay by latter part saw 2 ships S. Bends all sail out
Latitude of Ch 5.16 Long of Ch 107.

Wednesday July 1st

First part fine weather with dull times Middle part lay by
latter part stood to the lee saw 3 ships S. Bends
Latitude of Ch 5.21 Long of Ch 107

Thursday July 2nd

First part dull times Middle part also latter part the
same signified with a breeze last 4.47 Long 106.00
