

Remarks

Friday July 17th 1840

First part very rough weather. At 3 P.M. saw and lowered for a school of large Whales but they being very shy we could not strike we have seen whales 12 times and have taken eleven whales. Middle part finished making Latter part at 7 A.M. saw another school of whales very shy. At noon struck a very large one and lost the line of him. Latitude of Ch 3.9 Long of Ch 108.50

Saturday 18th

First part very rough. Completed in repairing the vessel with a strong wind heading to the N.W. Middle part much the same. Latitude of Ch 4.48 Long of Ch 110.

Sunday 19th July

First part strong trade by. Employed in stowing down at night finished stowing 84th. Middle & Latter part strong wind heading to the S.W. S. Ende. Latitude of Ch 5.28 Long of Ch 110.30

Monday July 20th

First part strong wind under reef repairs. Middle & Latter much the same heading to the N. under double reef. very rough. Latitude of Ch 4.20 Long of Ch 110.8

Tuesday July 21st

First part strong wind heading to the N. Middle & Latter the same. Latitude of Ch 2.50 Long of Ch 108.30

Wednesday 22nd

First part strong wind under double reef. heading to the N. Middle part much the same. Latter part stiff trade. Latitude of Ch 2.20 Long of Ch 108.20

Thursday 23rd July

First part stiff trade heading to the N.W. Middle part also latter part quite moderate made all sail for the first time this 4 weeks. S. Ende. heading out for Termination. Latitude of Ch 1.8 Long of Ch 108.10

Friday July 24th

First part cloudy weather with a light breeze heading to the N.W. saw Finbacks in Middle & Latter part wind light. Latitude of Ch 1.11 Long of Ch 108.41

Ship Station

Saturday July 25th 1840

First part fine weather wind light saw Finbacks & Blackfish. Completed in repairing the ship. Middle part wind light. At 12 midnight tack to the S. Latter part fine weather. At 11 A.M. saw breacher & towards 8 run for them. Latitude of Ch 1.18 Long of Ch 108.20

Sunday July 26th 1840

First part moderate breeze at 1 1/2 P.M. lowered for a school of sperm Whales at 4 1/2 P.M. took 3 large whales. Middle part lay by.

Latter part began and finished withing see. Latitude of Ch 1.30 Long of Ch 108.60

Monday July 27th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze began to hoist the tack & tack with us. Middle & Latter part greatly. Latitude of Ch 1.0 Long of Ch 108.48

Tuesday 28th

First part fine weather. Middle part finished making. Latter part wind light made all sail heading to the N.W. Latitude of Ch 0.20 S Long of Ch 108.11

Wednesday 29th

First part fine weather with all sail set. Middle part much the same. Latter part saw Finbacks wind light. Latitude of Ch 1.0 Long of Ch 108.30

Thursday 30th of July

First part wind light. Middle part the same. Latter part tack to ship to the N.W. Completed in repairing & other jobs. Latitude of Ch 1.50 Long of Ch 108.20

Friday 31st

First part fine weather with a light breeze heading to the S. Latter part began stowing down sails. S. Ende. Latitude of Ch 2.18 Long of Ch 108.10
