Sunday September 27th

First part strong wind heading to the N. Middle part equally latter part it sunnier saw a school of horses & buffaloes first off and took ones but him in
Latitude of Ch 4.12.8 Long of Ch 116.50

Monday September 28th

First part strong wind & squalls weather first off again for whales but got nothing Middle part took & took latter part strong wind at 7 AM put off for whales and took ones but him in sea began to sail
Latitude of Ch 1.37 Long of Ch 116

Tuesday Sept 29th

First part strong breeze at 3 PM put off for whales and took one large one took him to the ship Middle part boiling previous to our fishing the large whale was struck on small one and lost him by the iron breaking the latter part very rough began to cut sea
Latitude of Ch 1.34 Long of Ch 116.8

Wednesday Sept 30th

First part rough weather at 4 PM finished sitting and were ship to the N. Middle part strong breeze latter part heading to the S
Latitude of Ch 1.25 Long of Ch 116.55

Thursday October 1st

First part rough weather standing to the S boiling splinter the Bankstony on Middle part boiling latter part finished boiling and began stowing down side out to ends heading N.E
Latitude of Ch 1.40 Long of Ch 116.10

Friday Oct 2nd

First part First moderate under easy sail heading to the N at 3 PM saw a sail to windward lower cut our signal but they answered not answer it. We employed in stowing down Middle part lay by latter part saw the ship to windward employed in stowing down side the
Latitude of Ch 0.48 Long of Ch 116.40

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze at 3 PM saw the other ship amongst whales lowered and took one small whale and the other ship took two into our in and lowered the other ship found her to be the Rose of Bantuckito 3 from the 1480 Middle part made sail latter part took at the S and finished stowing off saw the Rose
Latitude of Ch 0.22.8 Long of Ch 116.35

Sunday October 4th

First part fine weather all with no standing to the S washed off sea saw the Rose to seaward Middle part took latter part fine weather sea
Latitude of Ch 0.22 Long of Ch 116.38

Monday 5th

First part sailed into the whale Middle part fine breeze latter part at day break saw 6 large whales in a school put off got nothing at noon lowered again struck and secured
Latitude of Ch 0.50 Long of Ch 117.30

Tuesday 6th

First part fine weather saw another school of 40 M bulls put off and got nothing and tried the large whale again but got nothing & this day has been rather an unlucky one saw the Rose to seaward Middle part stood to the N latter part saw a Finback sea
Latitude of Ch 0.19 Long of Ch 117.30

Wednesday 7th

First part lay weather at 5 PM spoke the Rose & got some iron from her Middle part stood to the N latter part to the S
Latitude of Ch 1.25 Long of Ch 117.45

Thursday 8th

First part fine weather Middle and latter at saw the Rose
Latitude of Ch 2.28 Long of Ch 117.38

Friday 9th

First part fine weather Middle part the same latter part saw the Rose on the S took at & took to the N employed in making fluke ropes
