

Remarks on board Ship Station
Saturday October 10th 1840

First part stiff breeze heading to the N^w Middle part the same
Latter part tacked to the S^w Employed variously
Latitude of Ob 1.22 S Long of Ob 118.18

Sunday Oct 11th

First part stiff breeze under reef Topsails & full moon
Middle part tacked to the N^w Latter part strong winds
to 11 1/2 AM saw a large whale giving quick put off got a
Latitude of Ob 1.23 Long of Ob 118.20

Monday Oct 12th

First part put off again and at 3 PM struck him
took him to the ship and got ready for butting Middle
part lay by Latter part finished cutting at 11 1/2 AM
made sail & see 
Latitude of Ob 0.55 Long of Ob 117.9

Tuesday Oct 13th

First part strong winds began to hail Middle part
hail Latter part the same to end doing well
Latitude of Ob 1.21 Long of Ob 117.40

Wednesday Oct 14th

First part strong winds at night tacked to the S^w till hailing
Middle part the same Latter part at 7 PM finished butting
Latitude of Ob 1.52 Long of Ob 117.45

Thursday Oct 15th

First part fine weather Middle & Latter the same
Latitude of Ob 0.30 Long of Ob 117.10

Friday Oct 16th

First part coopers oil for staving Latter part began
staving down to end weather squally
Latitude of Ob 1.40 Long of Ob 117.50

Saturday Oct 17th

First part squally at night finished staving. tacked to the S^w
and made sail Middle part the same Latter part
stiff breeze began white washing & see
Latitude of Ob 1.27 Long of Ob 117.58

Remarks

Sunday October 18th 1840

First part heading to the S^w with a stiff breeze. began to wet
the holds Middle part much the same Latter part
heading to the N^w saw all kinds of fish. but none
Latitude of Ob 0.59 Long of Ob 118.10

Landed the Sea

Monday Oct 19th

First part fine weather Middle and Latter with
saw Finbacks. washed ship outside
Latitude of Ob 2.50 Long of Ob 118.30

Tuesday Oct 20th

First part heading to the S^w Middle part the same
Latter part cloudy weather heading to the S^w at 10 times
Latitude of Ob 4.12 Long of Ob 119.8

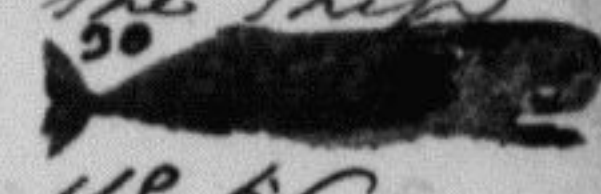
Wednesday Oct 21st

First part heading to the S^w Employed variously
Middle part and Latter with stiff breeze
Latitude of Ob 4.44 Long of Ob 119.20

Thursday Oct 22nd

First part stiff breeze heading to the S^w at 4 PM saw a
school of whales put off and struck a 40 lb whale but
the 2nd iron being loose the line was cut which
caused the line to part and lost the whale
Middle part tacked & tacked Latter part blowing strong saw
Esquimaux & see 
Latitude of Ob 4.50 Long of Ob 119.40

Friday Oct 23rd

First part strong breeze heading to the N^w Middle part
much the same Latter part heading to the N^w under
double reef at daylight saw a school of whales put off
and struck one at 8 AM took him to the ship
and began cutting at noon finished 
Latitude of Ob 3.44 Long of Ob 118.56

Saturday Oct 24th

First part strong winds heading to the N^w Employed
in clearing the decks Middle part stiff breeze
Latter part at 8 AM began to hail & heading to the S^w
saw beaches to the windward & see
Latitude of Ob 4.2 Long of Ob 118.40
