

On board ship *Patia of Nantucket*
Friday January 1st 1841

First part commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the NW course & with clouds coming about 4 miles at 5 P.M. quite a breeze Middle part weather thick latter part much the same with a fine breeze from the S employed in starting water minding sails &c
Latitude of 40 38.27 Long of 66 108

Saturday January 2nd

First part thick cloudy weather with a stiff breeze from the NW course & at night took in the fore & miz 98 sails Middle part strong winds with rain clouds over the topsails &c latter part moderate winds with thick rainy weather made more sail
Latitude of 40.0 Long of 66 109.50

Sunday January 3rd

First part weather thick at 2 P.M. took a light wind from the S course & Middle part took the winds from the NW with thick foggy weather latter part the same saw Dolphins
Latitude of 40.10 Long of 66 108.20

Monday January 4th

First part thick weather with a light breeze from the NW course & Middle part strong winds at 10 P.M. under the topsails latter part thick rainy weather with a stiff breeze from the NW
Latitude of 40.20 Long of 66 98.47

Tuesday January 5th

First part took the winds at 8 P.M. at night made all sail &c Middle part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the NW latter part much the same under the fore and miz the new main topsails &c under the fore &c
Latitude of 40.27 Long of 66 96.47

Wednesday January 6th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the NW course & Middle part is incapable of doing his duty being disabled by the Venereal Disease breaking out upon him Middle part fine breeze from the NW latter part wind light under the fore &c employed at various of the fore &c picking Oaken
Latitude of 40.27 Long of 66 93.30

From the *Patia*

Thursday January 7th 1841

First part fine weather with a light wind from the NW course & Middle part saw a number of right whales &c Middle part wind very light from the NW latter part weather cloudy covered for a right whale but did not strike &c under the fore &c
Latitude of 40.57 Long of 66 91.47

Friday January 8th

First part good weather with a fine breeze from the NW course & saw Finbacks & right whales &c Middle part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the NW course & saw right whales & Finbacks latter part much the same &c
Latitude of 41.38 Long of 66 89.0

Saturday January 9th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the NW course & saw right whales and Finbacks &c Middle part much the same latter part wind at 8 P.M. shifted the fore sails &c saw right whales
Latitude of 41.6 Long of 66 86.30

Sunday January 10th

First part wind at 8 P.M. weather thick starting by the winds under the fore sails &c Middle part wind at 8 P.M. latter part wind light heading 155 saw Finbacks
Latitude of 41.64 Long of 66 84.20

Monday January 11th

First part wind light from 155 tacked to the fore Middle part tacked again with the wind at 155 latter part much the same saw Finbacks &c
Latitude of 41.30 Long of 66 83.40

Tuesday January 12th

First part wind moderate from the NW heading 155 with all sail under saw Finbacks Middle part wind at 1 P.M. under the fore &c latter part weather overcast with a fine wind from the NW
Latitude of 41.36 Long of 66 81.18
