Monday February 8th 1841

First part wind at W with clear weather and a stiff breeze from the
made all sail and stood in shore saw one sail the Middle part that sail
latter part calm breeze bearing S 20 miles
Latitude of Ch 43.24 Long

Tuesday February 9th

First part clear calm weather saw one sail Middle & latter calm
Latitude of Ch 43.29 Long

Wednesday February 10th

First part fine clear calm weather breeze bearing S 20 miles
Middle part standing off shore latter part standing in. saw
Blackfish &c
Latitude of Ch Long of Ch

Thursday February 11th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the S
saw Blackfish & birds and as about night Whales at night
Towed off shore Middle part calm latter part calm
Latitude of Ch breeze bearing S 30 miles

Friday February 12th

First part at night took a breeze from the N 44 W breeze S 44
Middle part stiff breeze from the N 44 for the Island of Linnas
latter part blowing strong with rain breeze S 44 under reef the Taffel
Latitude of Ch 44.28 Long of Ch 16.30

Saturday 13th

First part fine weather with a light air from the W breeze S 44
at 4 P.M. saw 2 sails to the South of us Middle part lay too
latter part saw the Island of Linnas with a strong wind
from the N 44 under reef at 10 A.M. Linnas bearing S 44
with 2 miles in sight distance 20 miles Towed off shore and
at noon blowing a gale of wind took in the Taffel &c
Latitude of Ch 45.00 Long

Sunday 14th

First part at 3 P.M. wind at West bearing S 44 took in
the Taffel and under reef the Main Taffel Middle part
blowing a hard gale from the W latter part more moderate
at South reef Taffel and under reef I saw 2 sails saw the land
bearing S 44
Latitude of Ch 45.4 Long of Ch

On the coast of Chile
Monday 15 February 1841

First part blowing a strong breeze from the N 44 W wind
very rugged saw the Linnas under reef took a Whales
at night spoke the Lady Amhurst of London 1850 and
a Whales alongside saw Linnas bearing S 44 25 miles
Middle part took a Tack with Linnas bearing N latter
part blowing a strong breeze from N 44 W with heavy squalls
of wind & rain Tacking to clear the Island of Linnas
Latitude of Ch 45.14 Long of Ch

Tuesday 16th of February

First part very squally weather with the Linnas at N 44 W
under the reef Towed saw the 2 ships to the end of us
at night saw the Linnas of Linnas bearing N 20 miles
at the Island of the Linnas and bearing S 44. Middle
part heading S 44 with a strong wind at 12 midnight
took in the S 44 and Main sail at daylight Tacked ship
wind at S 44 blowing half a gale. breeze S 44 of 14
with thick squally weather latter part more moderate
at 10 A.M. at the Main sail and S 44 saw Linnas bearing S 44
Latitude of Ch 44.45 Long of Ch 10 leagues

Wednesday 17th February

First part better weather with a strong wind S 44 breeze
N 44 at night took in sail breeze S 44 Linnas bearing S 44
saw Blackfish &c at night saw the Middle part the same
latter part at the back of day saw Whales put off and took one
took him to the ship and began cutting with a strong wind and
a plenty of rain Linnas bearing S 44 25 miles
Latitude of Ch Long of Ch

Thursday 18th

First part rainy. blowing strong from the W at 2 P.M.
finished cutting and he with cold wet uncomfortable weather
Middle part rainy foggy weather heading S 44 S latter part
much the same blowing a gale from N 44 with rain &c
Latitude of Ch 44.50 Long of Ch 16.30

Friday Feb 19th

First part blowing a gale from S 44 with a plenty of rain
at 4 P.M. wind hauled to the S 44 were revised heading to
the N 44 began to bid sea water Middle part good weather
latter part fine light wind from the S & still taking
Latitude of Ch 44.48 Long of Ch 16.48
