Saturday June 19th 1841

First part light tracks with the South Head of
Albermarle bearing N.E. 10 miles employed in
painting boats and various other jobs saw Timber
& Blackfish Middle part lay too latter part calm
Kerbecough bearing N.E. 2. Saw nothing this day
Latitude by Ch 0.14 S Long by Ch

Sunday June 20th

First part at night spoke the Ship Remora of
B. Bedford Capt Smith 23 mths 210 Middle calm
latter part calm South Head bearing N.E.
Latitude by Ch 0.18 South Long by Ch

Monday June 21st

First part light air at night spoke ship Parker of
H.B. Capt Sherman 23 mths 1200 latter part calm
in company with the Remora & Parker
Latitude by Ch 0.20 South Long by Ch

Tuesday June 22nd

First part light here spoke ship Bellie of
Hantschett Capt Gardner 1250 23 mths out
Middle part calm latter part 4 sail in sight - saw
ing company with the Bellie
Latitude 0.22 South Long Kerbecough bears N.E.

Wednesday June 23rd

First part fine here from the South Head Middle
part made all sail and steered West for the
Off there ground latter part fine here from N.E.
Latitude by Ch 0.19 South Long by Ch

Thursday June 24th

First part fine weather and wind from West saw
a great many Porpoises in Middle & latter part light air
Latitude by Ch 0.14 S Long by Ch

Friday June 25th

First part wind light course N.E. Middle part N.W.
latter part heavy & struck Blackfish but got nothing
Latitude by Ch 0.49 S Long by Ch 97.58
Pro Hackett off club with the Remora

The Off Shore Journal

Saturday June 26th 1841

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze
springs from the S.E. course N.W. saw Timber
Middle part much the same latter part stiff here
course West saw Timber & Killer
Latitude by Ch 1.30 S Long by Ch 100.20

Sunday June 27th

First part stiff here course N.W. with the S.E. as
usual saw Timber Middle part stiff here
latter part stiff here heading N.W. with all sail out
Latitude by Ch 1.25 Long by Ch 101.

Monday June 28th

First part strong wind at night spoke the Topails
heading N.W. Middle and latter part the same
Latitude by Ch 3.26 Long by Ch 103.25

Tuesday June 29th

First part strong wind from the S.E. Middle
part much the same latter part do.
Latitude by Ch 4.57 Long by Ch 105.

Wednesday June 30th

First part strong wind & rough weather at night
spoke the ship Phelps of Hantschett Capt Allen
35 mths 1400 lbs Middle part much the
same latter part fine moderate weather
Latitude by Ch 5.5 Long by Ch 106.12

Thursday July 1st

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze
from the S.E. heading N.W. at 2 P.M. spoke the ship
Boz of Warren Capt Barton 14 mths 500 lbs
Middle part of the wind latter part running
off saw a sail astern of us
Latitude by Ch 3.48 Long by Ch 106.45

Friday July 2nd

First part strong here Middle part moderate
latter part heavy saw a large ship to seaward
Latitude by Ch 4.10 Long by Ch 108
