Latitude by Ch 4.12.2 Long by Ch 109.6

Sunday July 4th

First part strong winds saw a ship running off
Middle part steering to the South latter part
steered saw a ship to the S. E. and of course
Latitude by Ch 4.33 Long by Ch 109.20

Monday July 5th

First part strong winds heading to the N. Middle
part much the same latter part strong winds heading
to the S. E. at 10th A.M. saw a boat of two Whales
put off and took one & took him to the ship
with the boat after were
Latitude by Ch 3.20 Long by Ch 109.14

Tuesday July 6th

First part stiff breeze took 2 Whales to the ship
Middle part lay by
latter part fine weather with a light
wind began cutting the Whales at 10 A.M. finished
and made sail heading to the S. E.
Latitude by Ch 2.59.1 Long by Ch 109.

Wednesday July 7th

First part fine weather began B. Chirk and Middle
part hailing latter part the same heading to the S.
Latitude by Ch 3.30 Long by Ch 109.4

First part hailing
L 2.38

Thursday 8th

109.14

Middle part finished
Latter part heading to the S. E. with the stiff breeze

Friday 9th

First part good weather with a stiff breeze
repaired the Mainsail and heading to the S. E.
Middle part much the same latter part saw
Whales and fine weather moderate winds
Latitude by Ch 1.00 Long by Ch 107.42

Ship Station

Saturday July 10th 1841

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze
heading to the S. E. saw a number of Whales
Latter part took to the S. E. and 20 miles out
Latitude by Ch 1.30.1 Long by Ch 107.32

Sunday July 11th 1841

First part fine moderate breeze heading to the S. E.
Middle & latter part stiff breeze saw Whales
Latitude by Ch 2.58 Long by Ch 107.24

Monday July 12th

First part stiff breeze saw Whales heading
at night shortened sail heading to the S. E.
Latter part took to the S. E. and
Latitude by Ch 3.58 Long by Ch 109

Tuesday July 13th

First part strong winds at night took to the S. E.
Latter part took to the S. E. and in
having up later signal lanterns and other jobs
Latitude by Ch 4.30 Long by Ch 110.9

Wednesday July 14th

First part strong winds under Reef Repaired
Middle part much the same latter part as
strong winds steering off to the S. E. and setting sail
Latitude by Ch 4.48 Long by Ch 110.20

Thursday July 15th

First part strong winds at 8 P.M. huffed by the
wind under the Fore Top sail for repairs
Middle & latter part heading to the S. E. with the
Latitude by Ch 4.68 Long by Ch 109.30

Friday July 16th

First part strong winds heading to the S. E.
Middle part and latter part much the same with a
moderate breeze and dull times
Blacksmith Chirk & Burs off duty with the vessel
Latitude by Ch 3.0 Long by Ch 109.20
finished repairing the Fore Top sail
