Friday August 13th 1841

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze heading to the S. Middle part tacked to the N. Latter part it was seen a school of whales at 8 1/2 AM. First off and took one of the ship.

Latitude of Ch 1.62 Long of Ch 119.40

Saturday August 14th

First part finished cutting land made sail. Middle part & latter much the same weather.

Latitude of Ch 1.0 Long of Ch 120.0

Sunday August 15th

First part began to hail our whale. Middle do. Latter part finished sailing & heading to the N.

Latitude of Ch 0.59 Long of Ch 120

Monday Aug 16th

First part good weather with a fine breeze heading to the S. Middle part the same. Latter part to the S. S. E. saw

Latitude of Ch 0.36 Long of 119.50

Tuesday August 17th

First part fine weather with a good breeze at 8 PM saw a sail to the windward. Middle and latter the same as much. S. E. saw

Latitude of Ch 1.36 Long of Ch 119.30

Wednesday August 18th

First part fine breeze heading to the S. Middle part much the same. Latter part saw a ship to leeward amongst whales and off for the S.

Latitude of Ch 0.55 Long of Ch 119.45

Thursday August 19th

First part saw three whales put off and took 2. Middle part lay by. Latter part cut them in and made sail and spoke the Charles Carroll of Kentricks. Capt Andrews 14th mth 200.20

Latitude of Ch 0.32 Long of Ch 120

Ship Station

Friday August 20th 1841

First part fine weather with a good breeze saw more whales put off but got nothing. Middle part wind light. Latter part light began to hail & on the far took

Latitude of Ch 0.48 Long of Ch 120.20

Saturday August 21st

First part wind light at night saw the 6 Barrels. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part finished sailing and made off sail. scraped the lands. S. E. saw

Latitude of Ch 1.36 Long of Ch 120.30

Sunday August 22nd

First part fine weather heading to the S. employed in cleaning the lands. Middle part and latter part moderate winds heading to the S.

Latitude of Ch 0.36 Long of Ch 120.30

Monday August 23rd

First part fine weather saw a number of Finbacks. Middle part much the same. Latter part employed in stowing down oil & on

Latitude of Ch 0.14 Long of Ch 119.30

Tuesday 24th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze finished stowing oil and tacked to the S. Middle part much the same. Latter part off home

Latitude of Ch 1.30 Long of Ch 119.50

Wednesday 25th

First Middle fine breeze. Latter part at 10 AM saw a school of whales to leeward of S. E. saw

Latitude of Ch 1.5 Long of Ch 119.2

Thursday 26th

First part put off for the whale. Parat took 3 of the ship struck the fourth but drew it from him. Middle part lay by. Latter part cut them in and made sail heading to the S.
