Friday, September 10th 1841

First part stiff breeze employed in boiling
Middle & latter part strong wind
Latitude of Ch 0.42 S Long of Ch 117.55

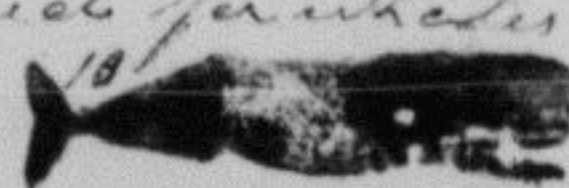
Saturday 11th

First part strong wind finished boiling
leading to the 1st Morning strong Middle
part much the same latter moderate
Latitude of Ch 0.16 Long of Ch 117.45

Sunday Sept 12th

First part strong wind leading to the 1st
Middle part the same latter part tucked to the 1st
Latitude of Ch 0.2 S Long of Ch

Monday Sept 13th

First part strong wind saw Panel lowered for whales
took one to the ship and cut him in 
Middle part stiff breeze latter much the same
Latitude of Ch 0.12 S Long of Ch 117.50

Tuesday Sept 14th

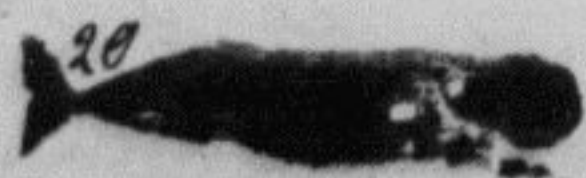
First part stiff breeze latter part moderate
began to boil Mr
Latitude of Ch 0.2 S Long of Ch 117.47

Wednesday 15th

First part moderate Middle finished boiling
latter part saw whales at 8 AM lowered for
them took one to the ship & cut 
Latitude of Ch 0.10 Long of Ch 117.50

Thursday 16th

First part cut in the whale and made sail
Middle part leading to the 1st latter part to
daylight saw whale again at 9 AM lowered and
took one to the ship & gave chase to the others
Latitude of Ch 0.20 Long 118.0



Remarks on board ship

Friday, September 17th 1841

First part fine weather at night struck a
whale made him sport thick floes when the
1 iron broke and he sunk saw him no more
Middle part boiling latter part cut in the
whale and made sail
Latitude of Ch 1.08 Long of Ch 118.2

Saturday 18th

First part boiling Middle the same
latter part finished boiling & cut
Latitude of Ch 0.15 Long 117.55

Sunday 19th

First part fine weather latter part at
9 AM saw a sail to the seaward S. Enos
Latitude of Ch 0.10 Long 118

Monday 20th

First part fine weather saw the ship to seaward
amongst whales kept off for her saw the whales
put off our boats and took 3 at 10 PM Middle
part took the third one to the ship after searching
the ship Mariner of Montserrat Capt. Palmer
11 months out 300 
latter part cut the whale in
Latitude of Ch 0.0 Line Long 118.20

Tuesday 21st

First part fine weather saw the Mariner 11 months
employed in boiling Middle and latter part
the same still boiling 1 ship in sight
Latitude of Ch 1.2 South Long of Ch 118.30

Wednesday 22nd

First part saw a school of whales put off and took
one with getting one boat stove 
Middle part still boiling latter part cut in the
whale and made sail saw a sail
Latitude of Ch 1.40 Long of Ch 118.50
