Thursday September 23rd 1841

First part strong wind and quite rugged employed in
boiling Middle part the same Latter part
finished boiling and began steaming To Ench
Latitude of Ch 1.10⁵ Long of Ch 118

Friday 24th

First part strong wind employed in taking care of
our fair Latter part began steaming the seaward
side of the After Holes To Ench
Latitude of Ch 0.20 18 Long of Ch 118.50

Saturday 25th

First part blowing strong Latter part the same
employed in steaming down side To Ench
Latitude of Ch 1.0 Long of Ch 118.45

Sunday 26th

First part blowing strong employed in steaming
to night finished steaming and made sail
Latter part heading to the southward
Latitude of Ch 1.120 Long 118.35

Monday 27th

First part stiff breeze heading to the sea
to night tacked to the sea Latter part tacked to the
sea and made all sail
Latitude of Ch 1.31 18 Long of Ch 118.41

Tuesday 28th of September

First part wind light heading to the sea
Middle & Latter part the same some Timbers
Latitude of Ch 1.13 Long of Ch 118.50

Wednesday 29th

First part wind light Middle part strong wind
Latter part strong wind with a strong NW current
Latitude of Ch 0.22 18 Long of Ch 120

Thursday 30th

First part strong wind heading to the sea
Middle & Latter part blowing strong
Latitude of Ch 0.37 18 Long of Ch 120.13

Ship's Station

Friday October 1st 1841

First part very rugged with a strong wind the
heading to the sea at 1 PM saw and put
off for a fleet of whales but got nothing
at 5 1/2 PM put off again struck the ice
drained the ice and the whale went off on business
Middle part stiff breeze Latter part at 7 PM saw
the whales again going to windward very quick
did not lower for them
Latitude of Ch 0.34 18 Long of Ch 122

Saturday Oct 2nd

First part strong wind heading to the sea
Middle part much the same Latter part
moderate weather saw nothing Dead
Latitude of Ch 1.2 Long 122.40

Sunday Oct 3rd

First part stiff breeze tack & tack with us
Middle part much the same
Latter part stiff breeze tack & tack
Latitude of Ch 1.20 18 Long 123

Monday Oct 4th

First part stiff breeze and still as before
current and no signs of whales
Middle part much the same
Latter part tack & tack
Latitude of Ch 1.40 Long 123.17

Tuesday 5th

First part fine weather with a light wind
heading to the sea
Middle part much the same Latter part wind light
Latitude of Ch 2.20 Long 124

Wednesday 6th

First part fine weather with a light wind
Middle part much the same Latter part ditto
Latitude of Ch 3.30 Long of Ch 124.50
