

Remarks on board Ship *Stetson*
Tuesday October 19th 1841

First part fine weather with a light breeze
course S by E employed in removing the men
from the storeroom to the Forecastle
Middle part much the same Latter part wind light
Latitude of Ch. 6.40 L Long of Ch. 138

Wednesday October 20th 1841

First part fine weather with a very light air
course S by E employed variously
Middle part much the same Latter part still
Latitude of Ch. 8.26 Long of Ch.

Thursday Oct 21st

First part fine weather with a light air
course S by E
Middle part strong breeze at 11 PM leave the
Ship too Latter part at daylight left off
S by E and at 11 AM saw the Island
of Hochoega of the Marquesas Group
with a strong breeze all sail set
Latitude of Ch Long of Ch

Friday Oct 22nd

First part stiff breeze with the Island bearing
N by E 6 miles distant at 6 PM
Middle part course W by N for Hochoega at 7 PM
saw the light on the shore at 10 PM have to
Latter part run down for the Islands at
8 AM have to at Porters Bay and went in
with the boat to Ench

Saturday Oct 23rd

First part being off and on at night the
boat came off with six Potatoes M^{rs} on board
Middle part at 9 PM made all sail and started
S by E for Otahiti Latter part fine weather
with a moderate breeze

Latitude 10.6 Long 142.20

Towards Tahiti
Sunday October 24th 1841

First part fine moderate breeze course S by E
Middle part much the same Latter part stiff breeze
from S by E to Ench as usual all sail set
going at the rate of 6 knots
Latitude of Ch. 11.22 L Long of Ch. 146.12

Monday October 25th

First part fine trades from S by E course S by E
Middle part much the same Latter part ditto
Latitude of Ch. 12.55 Long 146.40

Tuesday Oct 26th

First part stiff trades at S by E course S by E
Middle part at 4 AM have to Latter part made
sail course S by E with a stiff breeze S Ench filled the
Latitude of Ch. 14.26 Long of Ch. 147.50

Wednesday Oct 27th

First part at 3 PM saw the Chain Islands
bearing N by E 20 miles Middle part have to
Latter part wind light running along shore
saw several canoes to S Ench between the Islands
Latitude 15.05 Long 148.43

Thursday Oct 28th

First part running through the passage
between the Islands course S by E Middle
Middle part passed to leeward of Lagoon Islands
15 miles Latter part thick misty weather
with a light wind from S by E heading S by E
Latitude of Ch. 16.40 Long 149.20

Friday Oct 29th

First part light trades from S by E heading S by E
Middle part saw Otahiti Latter part being
S by E sharp by the wind for Otahiti S Ench

Saturday Oct 30th

First part light air spoke the large Beaver
of Hudson 14th 2000 whale oil Latter part
standing in for the harbor S Ench
saw the Atlantic of Bantucket 30th 12000 fms
