

At Otaheite

Sunday Oct 31st 1841

First part fine weather with heaving air off the harbour of Otaheite. Middle part the same. Latter part took the Pilot on board. 1. One.

Monday Oct November 1st

First part at 8 PM anchored at Tonnies harbour in about 12 fathoms of water. Latter part took our anchor and towed down to the harbour. began to water &c. Surgeon Samuel Corderly of London.

Tuesday November 2nd

First part working and watering and other jobs. Middle and latter part much the same. Discharged Charles & Coffin under the Consul's charge.

Wednesday November 3rd

First part working and turning the ketch. Latter part finished working. Took 7 boat loads.

Thursday November 4th

First part finished the ketch. Latter part much much employ'd. Discharged Thomas Rodgers.

Friday November 5th

First part employ'd variously. Middle part rainy. At 8 PM two boats came on board from the shore having been there a few hours on liberty. In a state of intoxication which caused the commanding officer to use means before he would admit. he was put in irons after striking the 2nd officer with his fist. Latter part at 7 AM put the prisoners in the rigging and executed him &c. he was put to his duty again.

Saturday November 6th

First part two boats was out trading for recruits &c. Latter part all hands on shore to church.

Sunday November 7th

First part rainy weather at 8 AM arrived Ship Barclay of Hanthicket 22 mths 600 lbs. Latter part employ'd in airing our sails and taking off water with 2 boats trading for yams and Potatoes.

Remarks on board

Monday November 8th 1841

First part fine weather. Latter part the boat came back with 14 barrels of Yams & 6 barrels of Potatoes.

Tuesday November 9th

First part boat heading arrived Ship Orbit of Hanthicket with 800 lbs. Latter part on liberty &c.

Wednesday Nov 10th

First part fine weather boat came back with 4 lbs yams found the trade in yams very thin. Latter part went again.

Thursday Nov 11th

First part employ'd variously in recruiting ship.

Friday Nov 12th

First & latter trading and recruiting.

Saturday Nov 13th

First Middle & latter recruiting with some rain.

Sunday Nov 14th

First Middle and latter recruiting anchors.

Monday 15th

First part recruiting ship &c. the useful jobs.

Tuesday 16th

First part recruiting, employ'd variously &c.

Wednesday 17th

First part getting ready for new &c.

Thursday 18th

First part ready for new when the wind came fair. Ship put on third officer of ship Placed of Hanthicket Henry Munro & B. A. Mory Boatmen.
