Friday December 24th 1841

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the S^W heading to the E^W employed in repairing Middle part much the same Latter part fine breeze from the N^W course East all laid out

Latitude of O^h 35.0 S Long of O^h 124

Saturday December 25th

First part fine breeze from the N^W course East Middle part strong wind under double reef Topsails Main sail furled Latter part rainy wind at N^W St. noon made sail wind & Latitude of O^h 35.10 Long of O^h 122

Sunday December 26th

First part wind moderate at N^W with good weather Middle part all sail set course E^W Latter fine wind at N^W clear weather

Latitude of O^h 35.20 Long of O^h 119.40

Monday December 27th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from N^W course E^W Middle part much the same Latter part light air from the S^W

Latitude of O^h 35.20 Long of O^h 117.01

Tuesday December 28th

First part light air from the S^W heading to Middle part much the same Latter part stiff breeze from S^W to E^W

Latitude of O^h 34.42 Long 115.30

Remarks on board

Wednesday December 29th 1841

First part wind at E^W at night tack'd to the S^W Middle part took the wind at N^W course E^W with a strong breeze and rain Latter part strong wind with dark rainy weather

Latitude of O^h 35.1 S Long of O^h 113

Thursday December 30th

First part a strong wind at N^W with rain under double reef Topsails Course East Middle part took the wind at S^W to South made all sail Latter part light breeze from the S^W to fine weather

Latitude of O^h 35.9 Long of O^h 110.30

Friday December 31st

First part fine weather with a light air from the S^W course E^W Middle & Latter part much the same making slow progress

Latitude of O^h 34.55 Long of O^h 108.5
