Saturday January 1st 1842

First part light air and calm with clear weather
heading to the S^W for the coast of Chile
Middle & latter part calm & clear

Latitude by Ch 34.16 S Long 108.30

Sunday January 2nd

First part clear calm weather Middle part
took a light air from the N.E. Latter part
much the same heading E.S.E.

Latitude by Ch 35.36 Long 107

Monday January 3rd

First part light air from the N^W clear weather
Middle part light air Latter part much the
same at the strong sails wind N.W. Course East

Latitude by Ch 36.7 Long 106.50

Tuesday January 4th

First part clear weather with a light air from N.W.
Middle & latter moderate breeze Course East

Latitude by Ch 36.13 Long 105.10

Wednesday January 5th

First part fine weather with a fine breeze from
the N.W. Middle part much the same
Latter part saw blackfish & Porpoises several

Latitude by Ch 36.33 Long 101.89

Thursday January 6th

First part moderate winds from N.W. Middle also
latter part carried away so 7 PM. Middle sail down & was
37.5 98.30

From *Pakito*

Friday January 7th 1842

First part stiff breeze from the N^W Course East
Middle part much the same Latter part
cloudy with some rain & sea

Latitude by Ch 37.24 S Long 104.55

Saturday January 8th

First part fine weather with a moderate
breeze from the N.W. Course East Middle part
the same Latter part thick foggy weather with
a very heavy swell from the S.W. wind N.W. Course E

Latitude by Ch 37.40 Long 92.10

Sunday January 9th

First part stiff breeze from the N.W. Course East
Middle part sailing with a strong wind up to the
Tapeils & Course E.S. Latter part under single
sail wind N.W. weather clear & sea high

Latitude by Ch 38.50 Long 89.30

Monday January 10th

First part strong wind from the N.W. Course E.S.
under single sail Middle part took the wind
at S.W. made sail Latter part all sail set with
a moderate wind & cloudy weather S.E. Course

Latitude by Ch 39.45 Long 87

Tuesday January 11th

First part calm with a heavy swell Middle
part took a breeze from N. with heavy rain
clear up to the Tapeils & Latter part wind at N.W.
with fine clear weather all sail set Course East

Latitude by Ch 40.28 South Long by Ch 85.20 West
40.22 with the Capt. Cook 46.20
