

Remarks on board ship

Tuesday March 15th 1842

First part strong southerly wind heading to the Eth at night spoke the Com Morris Middle part strong wind Latter part wind at 11th heading to the Eth at 11th M saw the Islands of Juan Fernandez bearing W 6 40 miles

Latitude of Ch 32.55 Long of Ch 78.30

Wednesday March 16th

First part fine weather with a stiff breeze from the Eth heading to the Eth and 1 E at night took in sail Middle part run 1 E Latter part took in the 1st saw a full rigged Brig 8th Dull times

Latitude of Ch 32.33 Long of Ch 78

Thursday March 17th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the Sth began to Cooper the Oil between Decks Middle part lay by Latter part Coopering

Latitude of Ch 32.15 Long of Ch 78.5

Friday 18th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the South heading to the Wth still employed in Coopering Middle part calm Latter part calm

Latitude of Ch 32.7 South Long 78.0

Saturday March 19th

First part light air from the Wth finished Coopering and made all sail Middle part wind light Latter part calm saw Blackfish

Latitude of Ch 32.22 Long of Ch 78.27

Statistics of Montserrat

Sunday March 20th 1842

First part Calm employed variously Middle part took a light breeze from the Sth at 1st midnight took a breeze from the Sth course South S. Breeze with the Islands in sight

Latitude of Ch 33.10 Long of Ch

Monday March 21st

First part wind at 1st with squalls of rain passed a full rigged Brig saw a ship to the Eth at night here too off the Islands of Montserrat Middle part lay off and on Latter part employed in taking off Wood from the shores with a strong wind from the Sth with the Islands bearing W

Tuesday March 22nd

First part taking off Wood at night of the the ship Navigator 300 and Mary 1200 both of Montserrat Middle part Calm Latter part light breeze from the Wth heading to the Sth saw 2 sails 8th

Latitude of Ch Long

Wednesday 23rd

First part light air from the Wth same as Merchant ship Middle part light air Latter part the same with the Islands bearing S 44 6 ships in sight and 2000 and no signs of Whales

Latitude of Ch Long

Thursday March 24th

First part light air from the Wth 4 ships in sight Middle and Latter light air the

Latitude of Ch 33.15 Long
