Tuesday May 24th 1942

First part fine weather with a moderate wind from
S.W. course to Middle & latter part the same

Latitude of 04 4.02 S Long of 84 99.20

Wednesday May 25th

First part fine weather steering to the W. in
Middle & latter part much the same

Latitude of 04 4.46 Long of 100.2

Thursday May 26th

First part fine light winds steering to the W. in
latter part at 7.40 saw a school of large whales
put off for them but got nothing see

Latitude of 04 5.0 Long of 101.57

Friday May 27th

First part fine weather with a light breeze saw
nothing Middle part of the wind latter part at 1.40
saw a school of large whales put off got nothing see

Latitude of 04 4.55 Long 102.3

Saturday May 28th

First part fine weather put off and struck a
large whale at 2.40 took him to the ship and
put off after another but could not catch him
at 6.00 began to cut with the ship Hector in
sight 10 miles ahead of us Middle part lay by



Latter part began & finished cutting

Sunday May 29th 1942

First part began to sail with fine weather see
Middle & latter part much the same without
luck & took in hopes of getting another whale

Monday May 30th

First part fine weather under whole sail
heading to the S.W. wind S.E. employed in
sailing Middle and latter part sailing & heading
to the S.W. with fine weather

Latitude of 04 5.14 Long of 102.2

Tuesday May 31st

First part fine weather with a light breeze of wind
Middle part much the same latter part finished
sailing & made sail heading to the S.W.

Latitude of 04 4.52 Long 102.7

Wednesday June 1st

First part fine weather with a light wind
Middle part heading to the S.W. latter part do

Latitude of 04 5.14 Long 102.20

Thursday June 2nd

First part fine weather heading to the S.W.
Middle part the same latter part employed in
steering down into the S.W. to come

Latitude of 04 5.18 Long 102.20
