

On the Line

Wednesday June 15th 1842

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze coming
W of S Middle & latter part much the same

Latitude of G 0.44 S Long 112.50

Thursday June 16th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze
heaving to the W. Middle part the same
Latter part saw a ship signalled with her but
could not make out her colors & at 4 PM saw
another ship ahead of us

Latitude of G 0.18 Long 114.4

Friday June 17th

First part stiff breeze at night spoke the ship
Cadmus of N B Capt Mayhew 7 mts 40 kts
Middle and latter running off WNW S. Cape

Latitude of G 0.30 Long 113.30

Saturday June 18th

First part strong wind heaving WNW at night luffed to the
wind to the S. Latter part kept off WNW to N with a
strong wind S. Cape

Latitude of G 0.38 Long 113.40

Sunday June 19th

First part strong wind from the NW at night spoke
ship Hercules of N B Capt Swain 20 mts 600 spm 300. S. Cape
& Atlantic of Bonaventure Capt Hogg 37 mts 1200
Middle and latter part steering NW of W saw the 2 ships
to the S of us S. Cape with a strong N. E. current

Ship Station

Monday June 20th 1842

First part strong winds with squalls of rain & heaving
to the NW Middle part under double reef Topsails Latter part
strong winds steering off to the NW

Latitude of G 1.17 S Long 116.7

Tuesday June 21st

First part strong winds under reef Topsails. saw and
signalled with a ship that we called the Captains of
Manituckit Middle & latter strong winds Latter part
kept off NW saw a shoal of Kellers Bay

Latitude of G 1.55 Long 117.22

Wednesday June 22nd

First part strong winds running off to the NW S. Middle
part much the same Latter part luffed to the wind on
the 1st deck signalled with the ship Three Brothers of Nant
and saw a shoal of whales to the weather of us going to
the windward very quick S. Cape luffed the ship
to windward with a strong wind

Latitude of G 1.10 Long 117.30

Thursday June 23rd

First part strong trades under double reef Topsails
heaving to the NW Middle part tacked to the 1st
latter part run off to the NW with a strong wind

Latitude of G 0.48 Long 116.58

Friday June 24th

First part strong trades running off Middle part
the same Latter part luffed to the wind
heaving to the NW

Latitude of G 1.33 Long 118.1
