part winds moderate with all sail out Middle part
latter part strong winds heading to the S same ship

First part strong winds tacked to the S Middle
part strong breeze latter part quite moderate
tack & tack with us S. Bonds as usual

latter part strong winds weather suggests S

Friday July 1st 1842

First part strong trades under double reef Topsails
as we have been for the last month and no prospect
of ever getting another whale. In heading to the S^W
Middle part much the same latter part quite moderate

Saturday July 2nd

First part moderate reef Topsails breeze heading to the S^W
Middle part much the same latter part breeze and
steamer S. Bonds all sail set fine weather

Latitude of G 0.53 S Long 113.30

Sunday July 3rd

First part fine weather all sail set course S^W
Middle part much the same latter part fine day
saw a Finback & S. Bonds

Latitude of G 0.10 S Long 114.30

Monday July 4th

First part fine weather at 1 PM saw a school
of sperm whales put off took one to the ship
with one boat stove at night finished cutting
and spoke ship Peruvian of St Johns N.B.
Capt Brooks 2 months 100th Middle part under
short sail latter part the same commenced
heaving S. Bonds

Latitude of G 0.50 S Long 114.20

Tuesday July 5th

First part fine weather at night in company with
the Peruvian Middle part parties company
latter part finished heaving saw the Peruvian amongst
whales

Latitude 0.20 S Long 114.18
