Wednesday July 6th 1842

First part fine weather saw the Peruvian but we could see no whales. Middle part heading to the S. Latter part much the same saw nothing else

Latitude of 0° 0.32 N Long 114.30

Thursday July 7th

First part fine weather with a strong breeze. Heading to the S. employed in making two T. B. Baskets. Middle part much the same latter part copying oil &c

Latitude of 0° 0.4 S Long 115

Friday July 8th

First part fine weather heading off to the S.W. Middle part luffed to the wind. Latter part at daylight saw on ship at 11 1/2 & 1/2 spoke the Marcus of San Francisco. Capt. Wm. Wood 18 1/2 mth. 1000 lbs. S. C. C.

Latitude of 0° 1.1 S Long 115.45

Saturday July 9th

First part in company with the Marcus. Middle part parted with her and steered off S.W. Latter part came 14 1/2 employed in repairing a stoven boat & S. C. C.

Latitude of 0° 2.20 Long 110.30

Sunday July 10th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze steering W. & N. Middle part the same latter strong winds

Latitude of 0° 1.45 S Long 118.30

Boards Ship Station

Monday July 11th 1842

First part strong winds from the S. & S. E. came W. & N. Middle part much the same latter part running off S. C. C.

Latitude of 0° 0.50 S Long 118.50

Tuesday July 12th

First part strong winds came W. & N. Middle part luffed to the wind to the S. & S. E. Latter part fine weather strong breeze no whales

Latitude of 0° 0.15 S Long 120.50

Wednesday July 13th

First part strong winds tack & tack with us. Middle part much the same latter part more moderate heading to the S. & S. E.

Latitude of 0° 1.7 S Long 118.50

Thursday 14th

First part strong winds heading to the S. & S. E. Middle part much the same latter part tacked to the S. & S. E. with small times & no signs of whales

Latitude of 0° 0.41 S Long 118.28

Friday 15th

First part winds moderate heading to the S. & S. E. Middle part much the same latter part saw 2 whales

Latitude of 0° 0.34 N Long 118.28

Saturday 16th

First part strong breeze Middle the same latter part saw a ship S. C. C. as usual

Latitude of 0° 0.53 N Long 118.10
