

Remarks on board

Sunday July 17th 1842.

First part moderate weather spoke ship Christopher Mitchell left here 8th on the 120th Middle part parted with her latter part strong wind saw the other ships to the windward of us

Latitude of 0° 1.22 S Long. of 0° 118.50

Monday 18th

First part strong wind heading to the S^W with a very strong sea current as the current having back for the last month a strong easterly current Middle & latter part much the same S. Combs

Latitude of 0° 2.36 S Long. 120.5

Tuesday 19th

First part strong wind spoke the ship Mitchell Middle part parted company with her she being bound to Pitcairn's Island Middle part strong wind latter part moderate heading to the N^E saw Timbuck & Killers

Latitude of 0° 1.17 S Long. of 121.0

Wednesday July 20th

First part moderate heading to the N^E without the least sign of whales Middle part much the same latter part heading to the S^W saw a ship to the W^W

Latitude of 0° 0.24 S Long. 118.28

Thursday July 21st

First part strong breeze at night spoke ship Columbus of Nantucket left W^W heading 38th with 12.00 Middle part parted. latter part strong wind heading to the N^E S. Combs as usual

Latitude of 0° 0.53 S Long. 118.25

Ship Station

Friday July 22nd 1842

First part strong wind heading to the N^E Middle part made all sails latter part moderate all sail out heading to the S^W employed in rifting apart the two big Top sails &c. Bull prospects

Latitude of 0° 0.23 S Long. 118.28

Saturday July 23rd

First part fine moderate weather with a ship in sight Middle part at 4 PM parted to the seaward of her. called her the Columbus her latter part moderate saw nothing

Latitude of 0° 1.1 S Long. 118.48

Sunday July 24th

First part moderate saw two ships to the E^W of us Middle part heading to the S^W latter part stiff breeze saw a Timbuck &c

Latitude of 0° 1.33 S Long. 120.10

Monday July 25th

First part stiff breeze heading to the S^W employed in splicing the 2nd Mast Backstays as usual. in a strong breeze Middle part much the same wind & weather latter part employed in repairing sails &c S. Combs

Latitude of 0° 2.55 Long. 120.48

Tuesday July 26th

First part moderate weather standing to the S^W heading sails &c Middle part strong breeze latter part repairing sails still on the patch

Latitude of 0° 4.8 S Long. 122
