

Remarks on board

Saturday August 27th 1842

First part fine weather with a good breeze. Steering NW saw a shoal of Killers two at night luffed by the wind. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part fine weather steering off NW saw & signalled with a ship showing colour blue white red perpendicular stripes. S. wind as usual with a slack current.

Latitude of 46° 43' S Long 133° 40'

Sunday August 28th

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze steering NW with a hazy ground nothing stirring as it has been for the last 4 months. Middle part of the wind. Latter part steering off NW. S. wind.

Latitude of 46° 38' S Long 133° 43'

Monday August 29th

First part stiff trades steering NW. Middle part of the wind. Latter part steering NW in hopes to see some whales on long.

Latitude of 46° 0' S Long 134° 30'

Tuesday August 30th

First part strong winds heading to the NW by the wind. Middle part the same. Latter part under reef Topsails heading to the NW.

Latitude of 46° 2' S Long 136° 20'

Wednesday 31st

First part strong trades steering NW. Middle part the same. Latter part made all sail at 4 PM saw a shoal of cow whales put off and took one.

Latitude of 46° 30' S Long 136° 55'

Ship Station

Thursday September 1st 1842

First part strong winds at 1 PM took the whale & the ship and commenced cutting at 3 PM finished and made sail. Middle part heading to the NW. Latter part under reef Topsails heading to the NW.

Latitude of 46° 2' S Long 137° 3'

Friday September 2nd

First part rough weather commenced sailing at 2 PM saw a shoal of whales put off and took one. Middle part lay by. Latter part cut the whale and made sail in sailing.

Latitude of 46° 4' S Long 137° 16'

Saturday September 3rd

First part fine breeze of winds heading to the NW. It more freshen sailing NW. Middle part made all sail. Latter part freshen sailing and made sail.

Latitude of 46° 3' S Long 137° 28'

Sunday September 4th

First part strong winds heading to the NW. Middle part the same. Latter part took ship to the NW.

Latitude of 46° 4' S Long 137° 30'

Monday September 5th

First part fine weather heading to the NW. Middle part the same. Latter part employed in repairing sails for steering. S. wind.

Latitude of 46° 3' S Long 137° 25'
