

Remarks on board Ship

Friday November 18th 1842

First part severe weather blowing a gale of winds from the East heading to the northward under close reef Main Topsails & Foresail with the waist & fore beams turned up on the canvas Middle part at 11 AM took in the Foresail. winds S.E. blowing hard with rain latter part more moderate winds S.W. & took in ship to the S.E. and set the Toppails &c

Latitude of 36° 8' S Long 130° 40'

Saturday November 19th

First part moderate winds from the S.W. with all sail set heading to the S.E. with some rain & fog. In this day proved the Steward Jose Fluter & his uncles to do his duty as Steward he was therefore put forward as so named and William Evans put in as Steward Middle part thick foggy weather with a whole sail breeze from the S.W. heading East latter part much the same employed in taking in & making sail &c

Latitude of 37° 9' S Long 133° 30'

Sunday November 20th

First part moderate winds from N.W. heading to the East with all sail set weather foggy Middle part much the same latter part much the same winds S.W. & course S.W. set the studding sails the weather foggy

Latitude of 37° 23' S Long by Ace 134° 40'

Monday November 21st

First part moderate winds from the N.W. course N.E. with thick foggy weather Middle part much the same latter part clear at times with a moderate wind from the N.W. S. ends

Latitude of 38° 40' S Long 134° 2'

Stetira

Tuesday November 22nd 1842

First part foggy weather with a clear sky at times wind light from the N.W. course N.E. Middle part took the wind from the S.W. latter part strong wind from S.W. with fine clear weather course N.E. with all sail set S. ends

Latitude of 38° 28' S Long 132° 13'

Wednesday November 23rd

First part fine weather with a stiff breeze from the S.W. course N.E. Middle & latter part moderate winds employed in repairing the 5th lub and other sails

Latitude of 34° 1' S Long 130° 18'

Thursday November 24th

First part fine weather with a moderate wind from the S.W. course employed in repairing the 5th lub Middle part wind very light latter part much the same course S.W. with a light air from the S.W.

Latitude of 33° 43' S Long 128'

Friday November 25th

First part calm weather clear sky Middle part calm latter part took a light breeze from the N. course & employed in repairing sails

Latitude of 33° 56' S Long of 128° 46'

Saturday November 26th

First part fine clear weather with a light air from the N. course & Middle and latter part moderate winds employed in repairing sails

Latitude of 34° 1' S Long 127'
