Wednesday December 7th 1842

First part fine pleasant weather with a moderate wind from the N.W. course N.E. & N. Middle part wind light latter part wind at N.W. & N. course N.E. & N. at the steering sails & with some light rain

Latitude of Ch 33.23 South Long 83.0

Thursday December 8th

First part weather cloudy wind light from the N.W. course N.E. & N. Middle part much the same latter part calm same as Tinkback & Porpoises L. Ende

Latitude of Ch 34.51 Long 84.36

Friday December 9th

First part calm as at clock with a clear sky. Middle part much the same took a catfish from the sea latter part light air and calm same as Crampus's

Latitude of Ch 34.36 Long of Ch 84.20

Saturday December 10th

First part took a huge from the S.E. heading to the N.E. Middle part rainy with buffing air latter part took a light huge from the N.W. heading, S.E. with fine weather

Latitude of Ch 34.40 Long 83.0

Sunday December 11th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the N.E. Middle part much the same latter part ditto

Latitude of Ch 35.2 Long 81.10

Monday December 12th 1842

First part fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from the N.W. heading, S.E. saw Tinkback & Porpoises Middle part light air & calm latter part the same

Latitude of Ch 35.5 S Long 80.17

Tuesday December 13th

First part fine weather with very light air from the N. heading to the S.E. Middle part calm latter part took a light air from the N.W.

Latitude of Ch 35.5 Long 82.20

Wednesday December 14th

First part light air from the Westward course S.E. at 1 P.M. saw a sail to the S.E. for a night made her out to be a barque ship heading to the N. & a cruising or taking a whale alongside Middle part light air latter part saw the barque to the W. of us cutting a whale. L. Ende with a light huge from the S.W. heading S.E.

Thursday December 15th

First part fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from the S.E. course S.E. Middle part much the same latter part wind moderate from the S.E.

Latitude of Ch 34.28 Long of Ch 86.20

First part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the S.E. Middle part much the same latter part moderate breeze from the S.E. heading to the S. at 8 am saw a sail to the S.E.
