

Remarks on board

Monday January 9th 1843

First part strong breeze from the Sth heading to the Cannote whole of sails set on both the Sth of us Middle & latter part much the same Moving strong from the Sth

Latitude of 33.15 S Long 81.00

Tuesday January 10th

First part Moving strong from the Sth heading to the NW Middle & latter part much the same wind & weather

Latitude of 33.4 Long 81.20

Wednesday January 11th

First part Moving strong from the Sth heading to the NW Middle part much the same latter part quite moderate all sails set as in ship steering to the Nth & W

Latitude of 33.10 Long 83.38

Thursday January 12th

First part strong wind from the Sth under reef to Middle & latter part much the same Tacking about the grounds in hopes of seeing whales soon

Latitude of 33.60 Long 85.0

Friday January 13th

First part strong winds from the Sth under reef with cloudy weather Middle & latter part the same

Latitude of 33.20 Long 83.15

Ship Status

Saturday January 14th 1843

First part Moving strong from the Sth under double reef heading to the S at 4 PM passed a merchant ship Spanish and Englishmen. It might see a sail to the Southward of us Middle part Moving strong latter saw the Island bearing to the Sth of us about 60 miles distant. S. and

Latitude of 32.52 S Long 81.20

Sunday January 15th

First part Moving strong from the Sth Tack & Tack with us saw a sail to windward Middle part Moving strong latter part moderate from Sth Tack & the NW with the Island in sight to the South of us

Latitude of 32.40 Long 83.0

Monday January 16th

First part moderate wind from the Sth saw a sail to windward Middle part much the same latter part stiff breeze from the Sth Island in sight

Latitude of 32.55 Long 80.30

Tuesday January 17th

First part moderate winds from the Sth Tacking about with the Island to the Sth of us saw a sail Middle & latter part wind variable from Sth & NW

Latitude of 32.22 Long 80.00

Wednesday January 18th

First part quite moderate weather with the wind at NW at night the Island bearing NW Middle part heading Sth latter Tacked for the Island & saw a barque

Latitude of 33.34 Long 80.00
