

Remarks on board ship

Thursday January 19th 1843

First part stiff breeze from the S^W standing to the N^W for the Island Middle part lay off the Island latter part went on shore for wood here

Friday January 20th

First part stiff breeze on and off taking off wood at night took off two boat loads left one boat with seven hands ashore Middle part lay off and on latter part went ashore with four boats for wood saw the barque ship America of Bristol Capt Richmond on moving Dumps out with the 500 of sperm & 200 of whale

Saturday January 21st

First part stiff breeze took off four boat loads of wood and the boat at night boarded the America Middle part heading to the N^W latter part strong whole sail breeze from the S^W heading to the N^W saw usual sail

Latitude of O^h

Sunday January 22nd

First part stiff breeze from the S^W heading to the N^W at night spoke ship Catherine of Nantucket Capt Hunter Dumps out with 700 sperm 200 whale Middle part heading to the N^W saw three masts at daylight latter part at 11th AM saw two sperm whales ahead of us S. Endeavour steering for the whales here

Station of Nantucket

Monday January 23rd 1843

First part fine weather with a whole sail breeze from the N^W with three sail in sight here at 1 PM put off for the whales struck one and took him to the ship and commenced cutting with the Catherine just in sight to the N^W of us Middle part lay by latter part finished cutting & spoke the Washington 1800 sailing and Catherine of Nantucket S. Endeavour heading to the S^W

Tuesday January 24th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the S^W heading to the S sailing Middle part moderate wind under sheet sails latter part saw two ships astern coming up with us fast S. Endeavour still sailing

Latitude of O^h 34.7 S.

Wednesday January 25th

First part fine weather with a light breeze from the S^W heading to the S sailing Middle part much the same latter part at noon finished sailing and made all sail set steering sails & Main Royal for Talcahuana with a light wind from the N^W steering S. E. by S with two ships in sight of us S. Endeavour

Latitude of O^h 33.57

Long 83.12

Thursday January 26th

First part fine light wind from the N^W course S. E. by S with every rag on her two ships in sight to the N^W of us Middle & latter part much the same same as sail

Latitude of O^h 34.22

Long 84.50
