

Remarks on board ship

Friday February 3rd 1843

First part left air from the 1st string & the South
being 18 miles to the 1st of Karakoram at night ahead
of the fog. saw a vessel going in Middle part lay off
and on Latter part thick foggy weather with the wind
at 11:45 starting in to the fog at 9:45 AM came to anchor
in Palcahuano harbor in 5 1/2 fathoms water S. One

Saturday February 4th

First part wind at SW with good weather began heaving
up the bottom Decks to cooper oil Middle part lay by
Latter part cooping oil &c

Sunday February 5th

First part cooping Latter part the same
good weather &c

Monday February 6th

First part employ in cooping oil Middle part lay by
Latter part finished cooping oil washed decks &
began to get the water casks ready

Tuesday February 7th

First part employ in variously cleaning hands &c
arrived ship *Enterprise* Capt Cannon
800 spurs 600 whale oil Middle part lay by
Latter part taking off water and masts

At Palcahuano

Wednesday February 8th 1843

First part strong wind from the 1st employ in
taking off provisions

Middle part lay by Latter part
taking off water and flushing hands &c sent one
watch ashore on liberty

Thursday February 9th

First part light winds at night rainy weather with
the wind at 1st employ in variously Latter part
fine weather with the wind at 1st employ in
in storing water &c the 1st & 2nd and the 3rd
deserted from the ship Station between the hours of
eight and ten AM

Friday February 10th

First part fine weather with some watch on
shore at liberty &c employ in in storing water

Middle part lay by

Latter part employ in getting ready for sea
Williams & Co. deserted from the ship Station between
the hours of 6 and 10 AM This day
discharged Samuel Lewis

Saturday February 11th

First part got all ready for sailing &c

Middle part lay by

Latter part much the same with a strong wind
Discharged Samuel Lewis paid off with any
order
