

Remarks on board

Sunday April 9th 1843

First part fine weather with a moderate wind from the N.E. & E. Middle part much the same latter part fine smooth weather with a moderate wind from the N.E. heading East

Latitude of 0° 24.39 S Long 35.2

Monday April 10th

First part moderate wind from the N.E. with some thunder lightning and rain. The heading to the E. Middle part took the wind from the S.W. course N.E. Latter part at 10.4 AM wind at N.E. with all sail set

Latitude of 0° 23.45 Long 33.30

Tuesday April 11th

First part strong trades with a thunder squall passed a Merchant Barque bound to the E. Middle part wind at S.E. course N.E. with a stiff breeze latter part strong trades from S.W. some few sail of vessel hands & work filling ship

Latitude of 0° 21.14 Long 31.40

Wednesday April 12th

First part strong trades from S.W. course N.E. & E. with occasionally a squall Middle part very squally with a thunder lightning and rain course N.E. & E. at 11 PM reefed the Topsails with a strong wind

Latitude. Latter part blew up raining and made more sail with a moderate breeze from the S.W. one sail in sight

Latitude of 0° 18.55 Long 30.00

Ship Station

Thursday April 13th 1843

First part thick rainy weather with a moderate wind from S.W. course N.E. & E. very squally one sail in sight Middle part rain latter part at 8 AM spoke ship Iris of New Bedford Capt Thomas 58 days from Calcutta bound home 1800 lbs and saw a big bunch of the E.

Latitude of 0° 17.50 S Long 28.50

Friday April 14th

First part moderate trades from the E. heading to the N.E. in company with the Iris Middle part moderate breeze latter part stiff breeze from the E. heading to the N.E. with the Iris in sight and two Brigs. So on with rainy weather

Latitude of 0° 16.9 Long 31.0

Saturday April 15th

First part thick rainy weather with squalls, wind from the E. & E. at 4 PM jamming with the Iris took the wind from the N.W. which caused us to take to the E. Middle part light winds latter part a thick rain storm with the wind from N.E. & E.

Latitude of 0° 15.30 Long 31.40

Sunday April 16th

First part thick rainy weather with a light air from the N.E. heading to the E. with the Iris in sight Middle part calm with rain latter part at daylight took a light air from the N.E. heading to the N.W. with the Iris in sight. At 8 AM passed a French Brigs

Latitude of 0° 14.57 Long 32.00
