

Journal of A. H. H. Voyage on board Ship
Saturday 2nd Sept 1843

Commenced with strong gales from N.E.
and heavy steering. Under double
reefed top sails. Middle and latter part
rather more moderate wind from the N.E.
Turned out reef to Envy by the wind to
the E.S.E. Lat Obs 37.44 Long 59.55 W.

Sunday 3rd Sept 1843.

First part these 24 hours very light - air from
the N.W. or 3 P.M. a breeze from the W.N.W.
steered East 2nd top down and steady
sail to Envy with fine breeze from
the W.N.W. Obs Lat 37.00 Long 59.00 W.

Monday 4th Sept.

First part these 24 hours fine breeze
from the W.N.W. and fair weather.
Middle part strong winds and
the squally latter part moderate breeze
and fair weather or 10 A.M. spoke
Brig Pocahontas of Newport N.H. 13th Oct.
5 months out Obs Lat 37.25 Long 58.30 W.

Tuesday 5th Sept.

Comes with Calms in E. with Brig
Pocahontas or 3 A.M. a breeze from
the S.W. steered East so Envy with
a fine breeze from the S.W.
Brig Pocahontas in sight a steam
Obs Lat 37.45 Long 58.00 W.

Notes of N. Beapara By J. S. Meares 1843.

Wednesday 6th Sept 1843.

Comes with light air from the West -
steering East - Middle part
latter part moderate
North and Cloudy &
and Barge head.

Thursday 7th Sept.

All these 24 hours light air from the N.W. & E.N.E.
and Cloudy steering by the wind to the S.E. & E.
Obs Lat 37.40 Long 58.30 W.

Friday 8th Sept.

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. & E.
and somewhat thick by the wind to the S.E. & E.
Middle and latter part strong winds from
the N.E. & N.W. heading to the East - or 10 P.M.
double reefed top sails squally latter
part strong winds and passing Cloudy
Obs Lat 37.10 Long 58.00 W.

Saturday 9th Sept 1843.

Strong winds from the N.E. and passing
Cloudy. Middle and latter part strong winds
from E.N.E. by the wind to the S.E. or 10 P.M.
have a Barge starting to the N.E.
Obs Lat 37.10 Long 58.00 W.

Sunday 10th Sept.

Strong winds from the East by the
wind to the S.E. or 5 P.M. backed to the
N.E. moderate and latter part wind
from S.E. by the wind to E.N.E.
Lat 37.00 Long 58.30 W.
