

Journal of a Voyage on board Ship Statens

Wednesday 25th October 1843.

All these 24 hours strong winds from S.W. & S. with rain & squalls and latter part Squalls and rain became to the West & S. employed sailing at 10 AM. took a tack to the S.E. & Brigg in light heading to the S.E. Split main top & entire Sail sent down the yard.

Obs. Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Thursday 26th October 1843.

Strong winds from S.W. & S. by the corner to the S.E. employed sailing at 10 AM. passed a big heading to the S.W. latter part gentle breeze from S.W. & S. weather by the wind to the S.E. (6) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Friday 27th October 1843.

Gentle breeze from the S.W. & S. and fair weather by the wind to the S.E. at 10 AM. tacked to the west gentle breeze from S.W. & S. at 7 AM. tacked to the S.E. & S. latter part moderate breeze and squalls of rain from S.W. & S.

Saturday 28th October 1843.

All these 24 hours moderate breeze from the S.W. & S. with rain and latter part squally with heavy rain working to the South and S.W. at 10 AM. took a tack to the S.E. & S. (7) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Sunday 29th October 1843.

Wind from the S.W. heading to the W. employed Stowing down oil in 2 main holds. Saw a big on Bergen to the W. to the S.E. Steamer Jolly Oil blown down on deck at 7 PM. heading to the S.E. & S. at 10 AM. tacked to the S.W. & S. (8) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Remarks On Monday 30th Oct 1843

All these 24 hours gentle breeze from S.W. & S. by the wind to the S.W. & S. (9) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Tuesday 31st Oct

All these 24 hours fine breeze from S.W. & S. by the wind to the S.W. & S. and Sail in light off the western quarter heading to the S.W. & S. at 10 AM. tacked the main top mast back stay put in and set it up again (10) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Wednesday 1st Nov 1843.

All these 24 hours fine breeze from S.W. & S. heading S.W. & S. at 10 AM. passed a barque heading to the North to Enay with one barque in light on west side. Gentle breeze heading to S.W. (11) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Thursday 2nd Nov 1843.

Fine breeze from the S.E. heading S.W. & S. at 10 AM. Sail in light bound to the South (12) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Friday 3rd Nov

All these 24 hours fine breeze from S.W. & S. heading S.W. & S. at 10 AM. fine weather employed at Sunday 4th a barque the ship (13) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.

Saturday 4th Nov 1843.

All these 24 hours fine breeze from S.W. & S. and fair weather heading S.W. & S. at 10 AM. Sail sent down at Sunday 5th (14) Lat. 54° 18' Long. 17° 25' W.
