 Remarks on Sunday 14th January 1844.
 Gentle breeze from SE to E by the wind to the
 NE at 3 P.M. from the side of Juan Fernandez
 Bore S.E. true bore 45 or 50 miles distant
 Lat 06° 35' 00" Long 77° 40' 00"

Monday 15th January 1844.
 All these 24 hours moderate breeze from
 the SE by the wind to the NE at 8 P.M. Steered North
 at 7 A.M. Steered NE by 8 M. employed scraping the
 rust off the Charn-bills and blacked them 8 M.
 Lat 06° 31' 00" Long 77° 30' 00"

Tuesday 16th
 These 24 hours is attended with moderate breeze
 from the SE and fair weather Steering NE by 8 M.
 no signs of Whales Lat 06° 28' 00" Long 78° 30' 00"

Wednesday 17th January.
 Moderate breeze from ESE to SE Steering NE by 8 M.
 unlent a fore sail to repair and bent another
 St. Encs with fair weather Steering NE by 8 M.
 Lat 06° 25' 00" Long 78° 25' 00"

Thursday 18th January.
 All this 24 hours light air from the SE to SE
 and fair weather unlent the main top sail
 and bent another at 4 P.M. Saw a Ship Steering
 NW supposed to be a man of War so Eng. employed
 Repairing Sails Lat 06° 25' 00" Long 78° 31'

Friday 19th January 1844.
 These 24 hours is attended with day light air
 from SE to SE and pleasant Steered
 N and NE by 8 M. employed Repairing Sails
 Lat 06° 23' 00" Long 78° 14' 00"

On board Ship Statira & N.B. before 1844.
 Saturday 20th January.
 Gentle breezes from the SE and fair weather
 Steering NE by 8 M. employed Repairing Sails
 fitting and taring Rigger 8 M. Lat 06° 21' 43" Long 77° 43' 00"

Sunday 21st
 All these 24 hours gentle breeze from the SE
 Steering North saw porpoise and blackfish
 Lat 06° 17' 00" Long 77° 20' 00"

Monday 22nd January.
 Fine breeze from SE and fair weather
 Steering NE at 8 P.M. Steered NE by 8 M. employed
 getting the Rigger 8 M. Lat 06° 17' 00" Long 77° 53' 00"

Tuesday 23rd
 Fine breezes from ESE to SE heading in NNE at 8 P.M.
 Shortened sail and steered NW by N at daylight
 made sail steered NNE saw Wharf back Whales
 employed at sundown 8 M. Lat 06° 15' 00" Long 77° 00'

Wednesday 24th
 All these 24 hours gentle breeze from the SE heading
 in NNE at 8 P.M. headed off NW under short sail
 at 2 P.M. were round headed in to the NE
 at 7 P.M. made the land at 12 M. from today Island
 bore NNE 15 or 20 miles distant Lat 06° 14' 39" Long 76° 14' 00"
 Lat 06° 14' 39" Long 76° 14' 00"

Thursday 25th January
 Moderate breeze heading off NW the land in sight
 Middle and latter part light wind and slight
 squally heading off West saw finback Lat 06° 14' 00"

Friday 26th January.
 All these 24 hours fine breeze from SE and some light
 squally Steering W and NW
 saw a number of finback Lat 06° 13' 00" Long 76° 00'
