the ship at 5 PM spoke Ship Chile 100 bbls
middle and latter part light air from the
West at 11 AM toward and returned to
a whale Ship Chile in Co. a Whaler

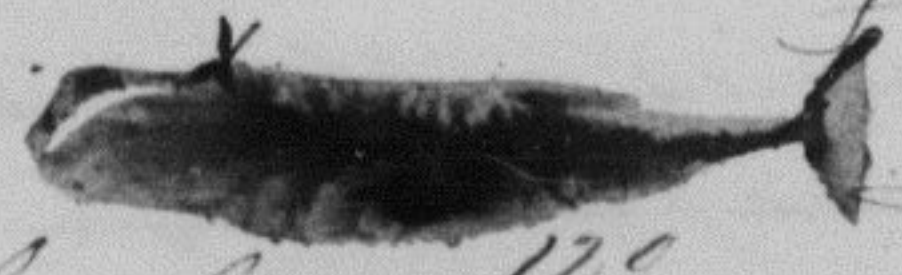

Thursday 22nd June 1844

Commenced with strong gale and rough wind
N. E. heading to the N. under short sail in
starboard water in 6 PM 8 PM and strong
Moderate breeze from North through the night
at 8 AM took a small whale to the Ship at 12 AM
had him in so Envy with light air from the
North and Cloudy Sat 6 AM 34.30 Long 145.45 E.

Friday 23rd June

Light air from the North by the wind
to the W. N. W. employed repairing Boats 8 PM
middle and latter part Calm at 8 PM toward
for a whale at 1 PM took a whale to the
Ship after having him in so Envy with
light air from the S. E. employed Boiling
Water head 8 PM Sat 6 AM 34.30 Long 145.45 E.



Saturday 24th June

Light air from the S. E. and Cloudy
at 2 PM had the whale in headed to the N. E.
under short sail employed Boiling up 8
Came Boiling Mr. Durham took 7 PM 8 PM
at 7 PM spoke Ship Chile a whale this season - middle
and latter part strong wind and thick at 1 PM
were ship to the South, employed Boiling, and
the Bone repairing Boats 8 PM Sat 6 AM 34.30 Long 145.45 E.

Sunday 25th June

Strong winds from the S. E. and foggy by the wind
employed Boiling, Ship Chile in Co. at 7 PM
were ship to the N. E. come East. middle and latter
part strong winds and squally employed Boiling
Sat 6 AM 34.30 Long 145.45 E.

Monday 26th June

Strong winds from the E. heading to the N. being
at 1 PM were round to the S. E. middle and latter
part moderate wind from the N. E. and
and thick employed Boiling, and Starboard side
214 bbls oil Sat 6 AM 34.30 Long 145.45 E.
