

Journal of A Voy to Kamtschatka on board
Remarks on board Friday 5th July

Moderate breeze from the S.W. and cloudy
at 4 P.M. had the Whale in view to the N.W.
and commenced Boiling and clearing up. Sailed
Middle and latter part - Moderate breeze and
thick heavy with N.W. Boiling and stowed
5.5.66 in open hole for 4 Oct 47. 15 - Long 114. 50 E.

Remarks on Saturday 6th
Light air from S.W. were to the S.E.
employed Boiling Middle and latter part
moderate breeze from the South. When fog sprung
on 10. American saw a ship apparently Sailed
of whole Boiling employed Boiling and stowed
down in fore hold for 4 Oct 47. 15 - Long 114. 50 E.

Monday 8th July
Light air on Steppans-tack employed
Boiling and stowed down 5.66 at 10. American
Spoke Ship Chile and at 11.00 saw 3.66
water so Eng with 4.50 air from N.
North at 6.00. Sailed and at 4.50
Long 115. 10

Tuesday 9th
Light air from the S.W. and thick at 1.00 P.M.
lowered and killed a whale had taken
him being lost the ship in the fog
tacked every two hours through the night at
9.00 found the whale took him by side
stowed down 5.66 to clear the deck so Eng
with thick fog but the ship is seen
for 4 Oct 47. 15 - Long 116. 50 E.

Wednesday 10th July
Fresh breeze from the West and fog
employed cutting at 4 P.M. had the whale
in view to N.W. and began to boil Ship Chile
in sight - a cutting Middle and latter part
strong wind from the W. to S.W. heavy with
N.W. employed Boiling and stowed 5.66
below so Eng with thick fog for 4.50 Long 116. 50 E.

Thursday 11th July

Strong coming from S.W. and thick heavy with
N.W. employed Boiling, &c.
at 6.00 P.M. had to cool down fuel for sail and
close reefed main top sail Middle part
Strong, & at 3.00 P.M. Moderate sea for sail
commenced Boiling stowed 5.66 below and began
scooping down so Eng with Calm & thick fog
below to the S.E. Sailed at 4.50 Long 114. 30 E.

Friday 12th July
Commenced with Sailing 12.15 July 1844.
Came with Calm and thick heavy with
South employed Boiling and scraping down
Middle and latter part - light air from S.W.
and thick fog sailing to the S.E. to S.E. employed
Boiling & stowed down 5.66 so Eng with
sailing up Sailed for 4 Oct 47. 15 - Long 114. 30 E.

Saturday 13th July
Light air from S.W. and thick fog & heavy
to the S.E. employed Boiling and sailing up
Sailed at 6.00 P.M. finished Boiling
latter part - wind from the N.E. stowed 5.66
of oil below at 10. American was to the N.W.
for 4.50 Long 114. 30 E.

Sunday 14th July
Wind N.E. heavy to the N.W. at 1.00 P.M. landed
found a whale and drew it
Middle and latter part - Moderate breeze from N.W.
to N. at 2.00 P.M. was killed to the N.E. so Eng with
moderate wind from W. by the wind to N.W. at 4.00
Sailed N.W. Sailed for 4.50 Long 114. 50 E.

Monday 15th July
Moderate breeze from the W. and cloudy by the wind
to the N.W. at 1.00 P.M. Middle part - Calm latter part
light air from the S.W. and cloudy saw a number of
Sailed at 4.50 Long 114. 30 E.
