Remarks on Saturday 14th Sept 1844.
All these 24 hours light airs in evening to calm
at 6 AM fresh boiling a whale which will blow
down 225 bls oil Stowed 1866 bls weight 1866
To Endy with Calves Lat 50.10 N Long 176.02 E

Sunday 15th Sept 1844.
All the 24 hours light airs and calm Stowed
1366 bls oil without decks at 10 AM low water for
two Whales with no success Lat 50.03 N Long 176.04 E

Monday 16th Sept 1844
Came with light airs from the South and fair
weather. Middle and latter part fresh breeze
from the S.W. and Cloudy Steady E.
employed Scropin home &c. Lat 50.03 N Long 176.28 E

Tuesday 17th Sept 1844.
All these 24 hours moderate breeze from the
West and fair weather Steady East
Sent up fore top gaffing and haul
the sail Lat 50.49.22 N Long 177.45 E

Wednesday 18th Sept
These 24 hours is attended with gentle breeze from
the West and Cloudy Steady E.S.E. at 7 AM sent
fore topmast Studding Sail to Endy with the
watch employed at Sunday 20th
Lat 50.49.45 N Long 178.20 E

Thursday 19th Sept 1844
Fine breeze from the N.E. and Cloudy
N.E. & E. at 7 AM Stowed 1866 bls Middle part
Raining latter part Strong wind from N.W.
and passing Cloudy Samfurling and haul
to Endy steering N.E. & E. Lat 50.49.53 N Long 178.51 E

Towards Moore in Ship Stair N.B. before 1844
Friday 20th Sept
Fresh winds from N.W. and passing
Clouds Steady N.E. & E.
at 7 PM Stowed 1866 bls Middle and latter part
Strong gale from N.W. to N.E. Raining E.S.E. under
double reefed top sail Lat 50.49.53 N Long 178.35 E

Saturday 21st Sept 1844.
Strong gales from N.W. and Raining E.S.E.
to E.S.E. Middle and latter part the same
very bad sea to Endy under double reefed
top sails Lat 50.47.32 N Long 178.50 W

Sunday 22nd Sept 1844.
Strong gales from the S.W. and strong and heavy
Steady E.S.E. & S.E. Middle part more moderate
made all sail latter part light airs from
the S.W. at sail E.S. Steady E.S.E. Lat 50.45.51 N Long 179.00 E

Monday 23rd Sept
Commenced with moderate breeze from the
S.W. and Cloudy Steady E.S.E.
Middle and latter part wind from S.W. & S.E.
thick and Raining
Lat 50.45.15 N Long 179.00 E

Tuesday 24th Sept 1844
Fresh breeze from the South and Raining
Steady E.S.E. Middle and latter part fine
breeze from the N.W. to S.W. Steady E.S.E.
Lat 50.44.00 N Long 179.15 E

Wednesday 25th Sept
Fresh winds from the N.W. and passing Cloudy
Steady E.S.E. latter part squally
Lat 50.42.00 N Long 179.15 W

Thursday 26th
All these 24 hours Strong winds from N.W.
to N.E. and squally Steady S.E. & E.
Lat 50.40.00 N Long 179.50 E
