Remarks on Friday 27th Sept. 1844.

Chained with fresh breeze from the N. and passing
blowing strong S.E. & E. middle and lower part
and moderate wind from the S. & S.W.
To evening with wind from the South & the wind
to the E. & E. South by 30.08 Long 153.45 N.

Saturday 28th Sept.

All these 24 hours strong winds from S.S.W. to S.W.
Strong S.E. and S.E. & E. at 8 P.M. and the keeper reports
to end with fresh breeze from S.W. & S. heavy S.E.
Obs. Lat. 35.18 Long 153.15 E.

Sunday 29th Sept.

Strong winds from the S.W. and passing Cloud
middle and to the part light air from S.W. & S.
North and strong S.W. & S. compass
Obs. Lat. 35.23 Long 153.15 E.

Monday 30th Sept.

Light air from the S. and strong S.W. & S.
middle part wind from S.W.
to the part fine breeze and passing Cloudy strong S.E.
employed Bunker-Bone and getting rigging
Obs. Lat. 33.23 Long 150.20 E.

Tuesday 1st Oct. 1844.

All these 24 hours fine breeze from N.W. to N.E. & E.
Strong S.E. on Ship in light of sail and
Bunker-Bone to the S.E. Lat. 30.58 Long 158.45 E.

Light air from the E. & E. & the wind to the
S.E. Ship Wm. Hamilton in Co.
Lat. 29.36 Long Chuan 158.00
C. 156.00

Thursday 3rd Sept.

Strong light air from the East heading to the S.E. & E.
Two fresh breezes Ship Wm. Hamilton in Co.
Lat. 28.58 Long Chuan 157.55 E.
C. 155.40 E.

Dry light air from the N.W. to N. and for

weather heading S.E. Ship Wm. Hamilton in Co.

Moderate breeze from the E. heading S.E. & E.
Left part Bunker-Bone at 8 P.M. Ship Wm. Hamilton
in light of sail from Lat. 26.30 Long Chuan 157.11 E.
C. 155.04 E.

Monday 7th Oct.

Dry air from E. & E. and strong S.W. & S.
S.E. & S. compass Ship Wm. Hamilton in Co.
employed at Sunday 20th above the ship
Obs. Lat. 26.30 Long 157.11 E.
C. 155.04 E.

Tuesday 8th Oct.

All these 24 hours fine breeze from N.E. to E.
Strong S.E. at 8 P.M. made more
Run off S.W. or is altered the N.E. part

in light of sail from Lat. 26.30 Long Chuan 157.11 E.
