Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> Comes with fine weather and a gale  
from S.W. moderating laying to midle  
and latter pleasant & moderat steering  
S.W. and so ended.  
Lat. 49° 00. Long = 61° 18.

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> Comes with fine weather and mo-  
derate breeze from the W. heading S.W.  
and S. by W. under whole sail the latter good  
breeze from the N.W. steering S.W. and  
so ended.  
Lat. 50° 07. Long = 62° 07.

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> Fine weather with light breeze  
from W. steering S. by W. under whole  
sail, the latter foggy with moderate breeze  
from N.W. steering S.W. and so ended.  
Lat. by D. 51° 28. Long = 63° 00.

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> Comes with foggy weather and light wind  
from N.W. steering till 2 p.m. S.W. and  
S. by W. since 2 midle part so the latter clear  
steering S. by W. and S. E. saw nothing calen  
later on go through the Straits  
Lat. 53° 32. Long = 64° 40.

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> Comes with moderate gale from N.W. W  
steering S. E. calculating go in to the passage  
but come on a gale he steered off S. E. at  
6 p.m. steered S. E. midle part the same at 10.  
latter too heading North the latter ditto at 1 a.m.  
was ship at 6. Staten Land East End bearing  
S. E. 10. midle Dist. 2 sails in sight.

Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> Comes with fine weather & moderate breeze  
from the North steering S.W. by S. E. mi-  
dle latter wind from the Westward heading S.W.  
hoping for good wind.  
Lat. 56° 04. Long = 64° 13.

Monday 11<sup>th</sup> Comes with squally weather and strong  
wind from the W. heading S.W. under single  
reefed topsails jib & main sail, the latter squally  
and more moderate at 7 a.m. took ship to the  
W. N.W. and so ended. 5 sails in sight.  
Lat. 56° 35. Long = 64° 25.

Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> Comes with moderate weather and heavy  
the bar under single reefed topsails  
heading S. by W. W. wind W. at 4 set whole  
topsails midle latter squally or moderate  
wind S.W. heading S. E. by S. from 12 p.m.  
the Land in sight off the weather beam.  
Lat. 55° 52. Long = 64° 50.

Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> Comes with fine & moderate  
breeze from S.W. heading S. by S.  
midle latter moderate steering S.W. by  
S. wind North the Cape bore W by E 20  
miles off. went board of Elisabeth Skindal  
Boston and got some papers.  
Lat. 56° 13. Long = 66° 07.

Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> Comes with light air from the  
Eastward steering S.W. at 1 p.m.  
saw a large ship close by the ship looked  
for him and chase till 6 p.m. and cut  
men off him. come board & steered off again the  
latter ditto, saw Diego off the S. bow bearing W. 40. W  
4 sails in sight.  
Lat. 56° 28. Long = 67° 28.

Friday 15<sup>th</sup> Comes with air from N.E. steering S.W. & S. by W.  
at 7 a.m. Diego bore about W. N.W. Eastern rock  
W. W. 20 miles off the latter strong wind from W. by S.  
heading S.W. and so ended.  
Lat. 57° 05. Long = 69° 20. W
