Frid. 21. Squally with strong S. E. steering N. at Gun
set. shortened sail midle slatter moderate breeze
Lat. 38. 12. Long = 74. 49.

Saturday 22. Begins with fine weather and moderate
breeze from S. E. steering N. E. at sun set
shortened sail, midle slatter same at day light
saw the Island of Machoa 30 miles off bearing S. E.
saw black fish and Hump back.
Lat. 38. 18.

Sunday 23. Comes with fine & moderate breeze
from S. E. steering N. W. by N. the Island in
sight stern of us. Put in at shortened sail, midle
and latter the same saw the Island, wore Ship &c.
Lat. 37. 50. Long = 74. 29.

Monday 24th Comes with fine & from S. heading to
S. E. shortened sails wore around to S. W. W.
midle slatter foggy &c. saw plenty black fish &c.
Lat. 37. 05. Long = 75. 20.

Monday 25th Comes with thick weather & moderate
from S. E. at sunset shortened sail midle &
latter fine &c. saw nothing but porpoises.
Lat. 37. 11. Long = 75. 22. W.

Wednesday 26th Fine and moderate from S. W. heading
N. E. W. saw one sail midle slatter ditto
calm, saw black fish, copied bread & meat
Lat. 36. 55. Long = 75. 55. W.

Thursday 27th Fine & moderate breeze for Hump back
without success, and so ended home
sick. midle slatter calm. &c. saw and
lowered black fish and so ended chasing.
Lat. 36. 50. Long = 76. 00.

Friday 28th Comes with calm the Boats part
got up to the Ship & to the L. Boat
and 3 to the other boats one piece, midle slatter
rainy &c. saw fish backs shared away the ship
Lat. 36. 26 Long = 75. 43.

Saturday 29th Comes with squally rainy weather
wind N. W. heading N. E. W. shortened
sail & wore Ship, midle slatter rainy & calm.
Olivia 2 years old today. Lat. 36. 19. Long = 76. 20.
and I thought much about her today.

Sunday 30th Comes with fine weather and moderate
breeze from S. E. steering N. W. by W. and so
ended spoke and sent letter by a Chilean vessel
to send by the mail cost 50. p.
Lat. 35. 25. Long = 77. 04.

Monday 31st Fine spoke and gammed with the Addison
13 hundred. 450. whole 42 on out. and so en-
ded.
