

April 28. Comes with strong trades steering N.E.
Monday. under double reefed Topsails, saw
Blackfish & porpoises, at sun set shortened
sail, midle & latter the same sighted blackfish and
so ended. Lat. 17° 30' Long = 80° 25' W.

Tuesday 29. Begins with cloudy weather and strong
trade wind steering N.N.E. under double
reefed Topsails, sighted one sail, at sun set
shortened sail, the latter the same steering North
saw one sail, & Finbacks.
Lat. 16° 55' Long = 80° 00'.

Wednesday 30. First part the weather fine and mo-
derate trades steering N. by E. saw
nothing, shortened sail, the latter same
made sail steered N.N.E. under whole sail
and so ended.
Lat. 16° 22' Long = 80° 34'.

Thursday May 1. Comes with fine and moderate trades,
steering N. by W. saw nothing midle &
latter ditto steering N. by E. saw Finbacks
and so ended.
Lat. 14° 46' Long = 79° 40'.

Friday 2. Fine & saw nothing steering N. by E.
shortened sail and luffed too heading E.S.E.
the latter ditto saw nothing.
Lat. 14° 00' Long = 79° 15'.

Saturday 3. Fine & moderate, saw Blackfish & shortened
sail, the latter the same saw nothing.
Lat. 13° 33' Long = 78° 50'.

Sunday 4. First fine saw and lowered for Black fish
got one to the L. Boat. the latter ditto at
8 a.m. lowered for Blackfish got 2. one to
L. B. and one to W. B. Lat. 13° 03' Long = 78° 15'.

May 5.

Monday. Fine with light air steering N.N.W. shortened
sail and luffed to W. W. midle & latter ditto ste-
ering W. by E. copied Breadth
Lat. 12° 56' Long = 79° 44'.

Tuesday 6. First part fine steering W. by N. shortened
sail, midle & latter ditto at day light steered
N by W. copying meat &.
Lat. 11° 48' Long = 80° 12'.

Wednesday 7. Fine & moderate trades, steering N. by W.
shortened sail, tried out the blackfish
the latter ditto at 11 a.m. finished copy-
ing. luffed out the Blackfish &.
Lat. 9° 34' Long = 81° 10'.

Thursday 8. Comes with fine & steering N. by
W. shortened sail, the latter the same
at day light made sail & steered N.N.E.
under whole sail and so ended saw 2 sail
Lat. 7° 20' Long = 80° 52'.

Friday 9. Comes with fine weather and brisk
wind steering N.N.E. at 2 1/2 p.m.
saw the Island Lobo, of the Lee bow
about 20 miles off heading N. by E. the
at sun set wore ship and shortened
sail, midle & latter ditto steered off N. by W.
Lame in sight. Lat. 6° 30'.

Sat. 10. First part fine & saw one sail blackfishing
we lochered for them with out success. putted the
Ballant sails steered N. by W. the land in sight.
the latter ditto steering for Porty.

Sunday 11. At 6 p.m. dropped anchor in 10 f. of water
all had letters but me, I felt very much disappointed
I wish I could see my little family for all that.
