Saturday 14. Fin & cruising off the weather Bay saw 5 sails, middle slatter ditto of the weather Bay. saw 6 sails

Sunday 15. Fin & the Bark of the weather Bay at 5 gained with Ship President, middle & latter ditto & saw plenty Skjids & no Whales

Monday 16. Fin & moderate off the N. head Rock Re. dongs bon N.N.C. 15 or 20 miles off. middle & latter ditto ditto off Rock Redondo, and N. Head. saw plenty of Blackfish & porpoises

Tuesd. 17. Fin & Rock Redondo bon N.W. by N. 10 miles off and North Head bon N.N.C. the latter ditto at 12 p.m. the Rock bon C. saw 8 sails

Wednesday 18. Fin & light heading to C. saw & spoke the Corrigare of New Bedford, 1000, of Sp. & 40 Blackfish, the latter calm drifting off shore to the W. 7 sails in sight & W.

Thursday 19. Comes with light air from S.E. heading in shore, the land out sight the latter calm, and so under heading all morning.

Friday. Fin and calm, sighted Blackfish Chaw and B.B. got one, at 5 p.m. got him on board middle & latter ditto employed slowing down oil &

Sunday 22. Fin & calm steering C. by N. with light air from S. saw the land bearing S.E. 40 2.

Monday 23. Fin with light air from S. steering C. by N. the land off the S. beam 10 miles off. middle slatter the same steering C. by N. saw the Island of ahead 150 miles off. W.
Lat. 00 35 N. Long = 91.45.

Tuesday 24. Fin & Calm saw nothing the Bark the North ward off N. Head & rock Redondo, middle slatter the same. At 11.00 Island bon East 50 miles off. at 12 the Island bon S.E. 12 miles off.

Wed. 25. Fin & brisk breeze heading N. C. by C. Port Phillip Island bon South 20 miles off the latter ditto ditto.
Lat. 00 57 Long = 91.45.

Thursday 26th. Fin with brisk wind trying to beat up to Tower Island, saw Timberlake middle slatter ditto & W.
Lat. 1 24. N. 59. 57

Friday 27. Fin & strong breeze heading C. by S. saw nothing. home sick, the latter ditto - Lat. 1 38. 1
