We ~~leaved~~ left after tossing about in gale
for 43 days bound to Massachusetts try for
Spermin the Lord be pleased to make us out with
a good catching this season.

January 8th I got out some home for Drury for my Ever-
& Little one, I expect to find her a great girl
when I arrive home if the Lord spare our
lives that we may meet again. How are
both of you to night, I hope well, & in good
spirits.
