Friday 17.

Fine & squalls and gained with the Hero, shortened sail, middle and the latter ditto 6 sails in sight.

Lat. 19. 30 by D. R.

Saturday 18.

Fine & moderate heading to N.E. middle slatter ditto 6 sails in sight steering N.E. &c.

Lat. 19. 30. Long 89. 17.

Sunday 19.

Fine & moderate steering N.E. at sun set shortened sail & were ship to the S. the latter calm & nothing in sight.

Lat. 19. 47. Long = 89. 26

Monday 20th.

Fine with calm, shortened sail the latter fine breeze steering N. sighted one sail N.

Lat. 19. 10. Long. 88. 57

Tuesday
June 21.

Begins with fine breeze steering N. at sun set shortened sail and luffed to S.W. middle slatter ditto sighted nothing.

Lat. 18. 47.

Wednesday 22.

First part fine with brisk trade heading to S.W. shortened sail middle slatter fine saw 6 sails but no whaler. Steered S.W.

Lat. 19. 05. Long.

Thursday 23.

First part fine then S.W. at 1 p.m. were ship to N.E. middle slatter ditto were ship to S.W. and so ended.

Lat. 18. 55.

Friday 24.

Begins with fine & with brisk trade heading S.W. shortened sail, middle slatter ditto heading to N.E. by E. 6 sails in sight.

Lat. 19. 12

Saturday 25.

Fine with brisk wind heading to N.E. by E. shortened sail, the latter squally steering S.W. 2 sails in sight.

Sunday 26.

First part: rugged with strong squalls steering S.W. land the New F. Topsail, shortened sail the latter rugged &c. 2 sails in sight.

Lat. 18. 55. Long = 91. 05.
