June 27

Fine with squalls 3 sails in sight shortened sail, middle latter date some 4 sails &c.

Thursday 30th

Begins with fine & moderate trades heading to the S. at 5 pm spoke & gained with Chilean passed the fore sail 4 sails in sight.

Friday July 1st

Begins with fine & with Calm middle latter date Calm 4 sails in sight sighted nothing

Saturday 2nd

Begins with squally & Calm. employed repairing M. ship sail the latter reef with strong trades no Whales.

Came with reef weather and no Whales the latter a gale sighted nothing

Lat. 19-42 Long 91-26

Monday 4th

This day fine & never to be forgotten by me, what thank you Sw. to day we had green Peas for Dinner & plum Pudding, I hope we shall enjoy many fourths to gather in good Harmony

Squally with ruffled weather 13 sails in sight, middle latter moderate heading to N.E. at daylight were ship to S.W. & L.

Fine & moderate heading to S.W. at sun set shortened sail and were ship to N.E. the latter date 3 sails in sight.

Begins with fine & moderate heading N.W. was ship to S.W. middle latter date & squally. sighted nothing

Moderate with squalls heading S.E. at sun set shortened sail &c.
