 First part fine & moderate
 sighted 4 sails, shortened sail
 heading to N.E. the latter squally
 2 sails in sight etc
 Lat 19-00

Monday 8th Begins with squally weather at
 1 p.m. saw 2 sails whaling at 2
 p.m. we lowered for a whale but
 saw him now on going quick to the
 windward, shortened sail, the latter
 ditto 3 sails in sight etc.

 strong trades heading N.E.
 shortened sail the latter squally
 & moderate sighted 2 sails
