

September 11th Sunday Begins with fine weather and brisk trades heading to N.E. middle stater squally and rugged as usual

Lat. 18-14. Long = 93-05

Monday 12th Begins with rugged weather and squally heading to N.E. at 4 p.m. were ship to S.W. the Bark under double reefed topsails and courses, the latter the same &c.

Lat 18-48. Long = 93-21.

Tuesday 13th Begins with rugged and squally weather heading S. at sun set were ship to the S.W. middle stater quite very rugged at 7 a.m. were ship to S.W. &c.

Lat. 18-54 Long = 93-15

Wednesday 14th Begins with rugged weather and strong squalls heading S.E. under double reefed topsails & courses, middle and the latter ditto.

Lat. 20-07. Long = 93-42

Thursday 15th Begins with strong trades and rough weather heading to S.W. under double reefed topsails & courses, the latter very rugged: close reefed fore top sail, & furled the Main sail

Lat. 21-16. Long = 94-02

Friday 16th

Begins with rugged weather and strong trades heading to S.W. the latter ditto heading S.

Lat. 22-14

Saturday 17th The same old weather heading S.E. by S. the latter heading S. by E. set Main sail &c.

Lat. 23-25 Long =

Sunday 18th Comes with squally weather and strong trades heading to S. by E. the latter clear further the Main sail to

Lat. 24-43. Long = 94-49

Monday 19th Comes with clear weather and strong trades heading S by East the latter squally and rugged as usual.

Lat. 25-54 Long 95-10

Tuesday 20th First rugged squally heading S. by E. the latter ditto

Lat. 26-42

Wednesday 21th Comes with squally weather and strong trades heading to S by East under double reefed topsails the latter ditto moderating &c.
