January 6<sup>th</sup> Friday Comes with cloudy weather and moderate from N.N.W. heading N.E. middle stater strong N. heading N.W. by W. &c.

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> Comes with rainy weather and strong wind from the N.N.W. heading N.E. moderating middle stater wind from the E. steering N.W. by N. and so ended with calm & much rain

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> Comes with strong South wind steering N.W. by N. N.E. by N. around the East end of Falk. Islands, middle stater ditto wind from N.W. heading N.N.E. and so ended with rain

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> Comes with clear weather and strong wind from N.W. heading N.N.E. under short sail middle stater ditto heading N.

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> Comes with strong W.N.W. wind heading North under double reefed topsails & reefed courses middle part squally & rainy the latter wind increasing to a gale from W.S.W.

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> Comes with a heavy gale from the S. heading W.S.W. under goos wing No. topsail & spinnaker hauled up part of the away, middle & the latter moderate made sail & steered N.W. at 9 the wind headed to W.N.W. &c.

Monday 16<sup>th</sup> Comes with squally weather & calm. the latter a gale from S.E. steering N.W. and N.N.W. before the day &c.
