

Saturday March 17. Comes with strong N.E. wind heading N.W. under whole top sails, middle stater clear and moderate heading S.

Lat. 27° 26' Long = 63° 27'

Sunday 18th. Begins with fine weather and moderate from the N.E. heading N.W. under whole sail with stater clear wind from the E. N.E. steering N.W. by N. W.

Lat 29° 10' Long = 65° 45'

Monday 19. Comes with cloudy weather and brisk wind from E. N.E. steering N.W. by N. middle and latter clear W.

Lat 31° 09' Long = 67° 50'

Tuesday 20. Comes with strong wind from E. N.E. steering N.N.W. & W. middle stater clear moderate from the East steering N.N.W. W.

Lat 33° 10' Long = 69° 10'

Wednesday 21. Begins with moderate breeze from the Eastward steering N.N.W. middle stater a gale from N.W. heading W. W. with heavy squalls W.

Lat 33° 22' Long = 70° 30'

Thursday 22. Comes with a gale from W. N.W. with heavy squalls & thunder with lightning heading North, laying too under close reefed top sail & spencers middle and the latter a gale from W. N.W. heading N. sighted 2 ships.

Lat 33° 00' Long = 69° 30'

Friday 23. Begins with a smart gale from the W. N.W. heading North under close reefed top sails & spencers, middle part clear the latter moderating and heading N. N.W. W.

Lat 33° 45' Long = 69° 20'

Saturday 24th. Begins with thick weather and moderate from the W. heading N.N.W. middle part wind S.W. steering N.N.W. the latter rainy with strong N.W. wind heading N. N.E. and veered with head wind

Lat 36° 34' 40'

Sunday 25. Comes with a N.W. wind and much rain heading under close reefed top sail & reefed fore sail N.N.E. at 3 p.m. wore ship to W. S.W. middle stater clear and calm. W.

Lat 34° 25' Long = 70° 18'

Monday 26. Comes with rainy weather and moderate from the E. steering N. by W. middle part rainy & squally.

Lat 34° 45' Long = 71° 10'
