Tuesday. Begins with moderate S.W. and calm. middle stater strong from N.W. heading to N.E. have the Try works over board. &c.
Lat. $35^{\circ} 42'$ Long. $70^{\circ} 42'$

Wednesday 28.

Comes with strong N.W. Stream. = heading N.N.E. under double reefed Topsails to courses, the latter fine with light air from S.E. steering N.W. $\frac{1}{2}$ N. and so ended.

Thursday 29.

Begins with fine weather and calm, middle stater strong N.W. heading N.N.E. at 12 p.m. backed Ship to W. & W. several sails in sight.

Begins with fine weather and strong N.W. wind heading W. & W. under double reefed Topsails, middle stater sets from S.W. steering N.W. by N. and so ended.

Comes with fine and moderate S.W. wind steering N.W. by N. middle stater steered N. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. at 10 am spoke the Schooner C. F. Young &c.

Begins with fine weather and brisk breeze from S.W. steering for Mon. Lagoon light and shipped the Course E. N.E. for Block Island at 2 p.m. sighted Block Island steering East.
